a collection of documentaries about the first world war from the onset of the great war to the tragic final day on which over 13 000 men died the films span the turbulent four year period from 1914 1918 that saw over 40 million casualties and 20 million deaths

designed for those studying law for the first time this book explores where the english common law came from

a historical introduction to the philosophy of mind is designed both to provide a selection of core readings on the subject and to make those readings accessible by providing commentaries to guide the reader through initially intimidating material each commentary explains technical concepts and provides background on obscure arguments as they arise setting them in the historical and intellectual milieu from which they emerged the readings concentrate on providing the student with a solid grounding in the theories of representative figures of the major philosophical movements from plato and aristotle to important recent figures such as fodor and dennett a glossary of key terms is also included

john losee provides a balanced and engaging survey of the development of views about scientific method ideal for those coming to the subject for the first time this fully updated new edition incorporates discussion on contemporary debates including philosophy of biology normative naturalism theory appraisal experimental practice and scientific realism concise profiles of the major philosophers discussed within the text are provided including aristotle galileo newton whewell hempel and kuhn

the historical roots of english land law originally published london oxford university press 1927 xxiv 339 pp one of the most distinguished historians of english common law holdsworth produced this manual to provide students of real property with a concise history of the field this background was necessary he argued because contemporary land law was hard to comprehend apart from its history holdsworth has cheerfully carried through the task of giving us an elementary survey of one part of the vast subject in the mastery of which he stands alone most writers of manuals have to popularize the results of the labour of others professor holdsworth need pillage few storehouses but his own law quarterly review 44 1928 105 william s holdsworth 1871 1944 was a professor of constitutional law at the university of cambridge from 1903 1966 and became the vinerian professor of english law at oxford in 1922 he is well known for his monumental a history of english law 1903 1966 and other works such as charles dickens as a legal historian 1929 and some makers of english law 1938
