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this clear objective introduction to the politics of czechoslovakia and the successor czech and slovak republics provides a comprehensive analysis of czechoslovakia in the postcommunist period carol leff builds a framework for understanding the dynamics of the triple transition democratization marketization and a national transformation that has reconfigured the dynamic between state and nation she shows how the interaction of these three transformational agendas has shaped czechoslovakia's development ultimately culminating in the paradoxical disintegration of a state that most of its citizens wished to preserve the book offers a valuable case study of a country coming back to europe but it also provides an opportunity for analyzing the influence of communism on what had been a significant interwar european state the book's strong comparative element will make it invaluable as well for those seeking to understand contemporary central and eastern europe

this title was first published in 2001 based on a unique set of structured interviews with parliamentarians and additional interviews with party leaders and activists this significant volume provides an illuminating account of the formation of the new democracies in czechoslovakia and later the czech republic and slovakia examining efforts to construct stable democratic parliamentary regimes in the wake of communist breakdown it provides a rigorous analysis of parliaments relations with the electorate and the executive as well as their internal working richly detailed and clearly written this original study is an invaluable addition to the collection of anyone interested in post communist europe or parliamentary studies

the book is a collaborative document nine papers written by slovakia's president rudolf schuster and eight of his high level government officials with commentaries by eight north american scholars

this selected issues paper assesses slovakia's household and private sector indebtedness against macroeconomic fundamentals identifies key vulnerabilities from rapid household credit growth assesses policy responses to date and presents further policy options strong private sector credit growth has persisted for over a decade and resulted in household debt that is high relative to peers credit is now growing in riskier segments housing prices have also started to reflect pressures from strong credit growth the paper describes assessments of household and private sector debt levels relative to fundamentals it also describes the policy response to date and assesses its effectiveness econometric analysis suggests that household indebtedness is growing at a faster pace than implied by economic fundamentals the credit cycle seems to have reached its post crisis high the credit cyclogram compiled by the national bank of slovakia is an aggregation of a set of core and supplementary variables evaluated against distributions of their own historical values to disentangle factors cyclical credit growth

this is the second of three books by jeffrey simon on emerging post communist countries to recently join nato as with the previous volume hungary this book represents a tremendous amount of first hand research grounded in primary source material and personal interviews with key civil and military leaders visit our website for sample chapters

czechoslovakia has captured the nation's imagination throughout the twentieth century the allied betrayal of the country to nazi germany in 1938 was to demonstrate the appalling consequences of naive appeasement of aggression the wholesale reform of soviet communism in the prague spring of 1968 won western support and sympathy when it was crushed by warsaw pact tanks the fierce communist regime thereafter was brought down almost magically in 1989 czechoslovakia added to the international political vocabulary the term velvet revolution and the velvet metaphor has characterised much of the country's path breaking

postcommunist transformation and its peaceful break up in 1993 in separate chapters on history politics economics foreign relations and the new czech identity this book not only applauds the successes of the czech republic since 1993 but also uncovers the frayed edges of the velvet nation

when ladislav holy precipitately left czechoslovakia for the uk in 1968 he was already one of the leading anthropologists in central europe in the following decades he made important field studies in africa since 1986 he has been engaged in research in the czech republic and he brings to this timely study of national identity the skills of a seasoned researcher a cosmopolitan perspective and the insights of an insider drawing on historical and literary sources as well as ethnography he analyses czech discourses on national identity he argues that there were specifically czech aspects to the communist regime and to the velvet revolution and paying particular attention to symbolic representations of what it means to be czech he explores how notions of czech identity were involved in the debates surrounding the fall of communism and the emergence of a new social system

this edited collection analyses various aspects of slovakia's economy including recent developments and events such as the covid 19 pandemic and war in ukraine highlighting issues that arise from the current economic model making it difficult for slovakia to revitalize and adapt the economy to new circumstances
