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in 2010 the Australian government decided that it would not propose a human rights act despite the relevant recommendation of the 2008 09 national human rights consultation instead it introduced a human rights framework comprising several measures to enhance human rights protection including the human rights parliamentary scrutiny act 2011 the scrutiny regime under that act was designed to ensure rights would be given due consideration before commonwealth legislation was passed the act created a unique bipartite dialogue system involving a formal interchange on rights compatibility between the executive and parliament while excluding the courts this set the commonwealth apart from jurisdictions such as the act victoria new zealand and the uk which have statutory rights instruments administered by their courts the book presents a detailed study of all aspects of the scrutiny

regime and compares the regime with its closest counterparts overseas in assessing the regime's impact it argues that a system in which the executive and parliament are responsible both for protecting rights and for remedying rights breaches is neither more legitimate nor more effective than one involving all three branches of government accordingly it calls for strengthening reforms

australian climate policy and diplomacy provides a well overdue critique of existing and high profile publications that convey the greenhouse mafia hypothesis which posits that australia's weak policy response to climate change is the result of a menacing domestic fossil fuel lobby ben l parr argues that the shared government industry discourse about protecting australia's industrial competitiveness has had a more decisive influence in shaping and legitimising australian climate policy than the direct lobbying tactics of the fossil fuel industry parr also reveals how the divergent foreign policy discourses and traditions of australia's two major political parties as internationalist versus alliance focused have enabled and constrained their climate diplomacy and domestic policies over time to demonstrate his argument he presents a discourse analysis woven into a chronological policy narrative comprising more than 1000 primary texts media releases interviews and speeches generated by prime ministers and key fossil fuel lobbyists overall this volume illustrates how domestic forces have and are influencing australia's climate policy in doing so it also provides a framework that

can be adapted to examine climate mitigation policies in other countries notably canada and the us this book will be of interest to students and scholars of climate change environmental policy and governance and australian climate change policy and politics more specifically as well as policymakers and practitioners working in these fields

despite the australian constitution implying school education to be a state responsibility the commonwealth has increasingly interfered with state school education the australian government muscling in on school education therefore offers a historical account of this government involvement in australian education from federation to the present day providing a much needed fully updated and relevant overview the topic arguing that education has become an arena for competing political forces this book examines the powerful influence of the commonwealth over education and the political motives behind it exploring how politics influences aspects of the curriculum teaching standards assessment and reporting funding teacher selection and policy more broadly ultimately questioning whether this influence is in the interests of the members of the community who depend on education the book holds government engagement in education to account taking the major epochs of federalism as an organizing framework the book s chapters include explorations of the efficiency dynamic and the progressive years 1919 39 postwar imperatives and the menzies years 1949 72 coordinative federalism and treading softly the whitlam years 1972 5 and fraser years 1975 83 corporate federalism the hawke keating years 1983 96 supply side federalism and globalization the howard years 1996 2007 national control and the rudd gillard abbott turnbull and morrison years 2007 15 a thorough and significant examination of the historical engagement of the australian government in education this book is essential reading for student teachers and postgraduate students in education studies and politics
