workplace accidents and injuries it also incorporates stress as a factor in rates of accidents and injuries and suggests ways in which workplace safety cultures can be fostered and improved this book will be an invaluable tool for students of management especially those with an interest in small businesses

and organisational settings leading industry professionals and educators explain how to identify key workplace hazards including chemical agents such as dusts metals and gases physical agents such as noise radiation and extremes of heat and cold and microbiological agents they outline assessment procedures and processes for identifying exposure levels they also explain how to evaluate risk and follow safety guidelines to control and manage these hazards effectively chapters are heavily illustrated with detailed case studies diagrams flowcharts and photos practical guidelines are provided for managing each hazard type this third edition has been extensively revised and updated and reflects current research evidence and the workplace health and safety legislation on workplace hazards principles of occupational health and hygiene is an essential reference for occupational hygienists and anyone in an occupational health and safety role

occupational health a guide to sources of information is a compilation of papers that can be used as reference when seeking information and knowledge related to health hazards found in the workplace the information given in the book pertains mostly to the united kingdom though additional references can be helpful when used in other countries the text enumerates the qualifications and trainings required for occupational physicians medical officers consultants nurses and part time workers the book also includes training courses in the usa australia and south africa the epidemiological approach to occupational health hazards and problems including the spread of community diseases in terms of age social class and time factors is discussed of interest is the chapter on ergonomics where the interrelations between humans and their occupations are studied another useful chapter for administrators in the occupational health sector is the design of an occupational health department and first aid stations related topics include management handling trade unions and even environmental pollution details of occupational medicine in selected countries of the european economic community the work of the who and the ilo and other additional information from countries such as israel india sudan and zambia are included this book is an informative reading for physicians nurses hygienists ergonomists biomedical engineers and students and trainees in occupational medicine

offering a balance of theory and practice with guides for further reading this is a clinical guide for the practitioner in the widest sense physicians nurses occupational hygienists safety officers environmental health officers and personnel managers with coverage of both medicine and hygiene and including sections on oh law it is a primer for appropriate courses and provides all that the interested medical student would need to know

the present manual tries to respond to the specific needs of occupational health epidemiology rather than a comprehensive review of the subject the book presents a

series of articles the first four chapters deal with general principles and definitions in occupational epidemiology and describe the work related hazards and diseases chapter 5, 6 and 7 deal with information collection and the use of data in the assessment of health risks and in descriptive epidemiology general methods for epidemiological studies are discussed the following chapters address specific aspects such as the study of combined effects the statistical analysis of epidemiological data the validity aspects of epidemiological studies including consideration on the problems of false positive and false negative results and the basis for causality judgment or the particular interest of experimental epidemiology in occupational health chapters cover two special issues of importance to workers health namely occupational stress and the epidemiology of accidents

the legal requirements are covered in the control of noise at work regulations 2005 cnawrs see box 1.1 the exposure action values eavs are the noise exposure levels at which certain actions are required these actions relate to need for risk assessment controlling exposure health surveillance and the provision of information and training the exposure limit values elvs are the levels of noise above which employees may not be exposed the eavs and elvs are listed in table 1.1

this book discusses occupational health and safety including occupational policies legislative acts and laws for protection of workers epidemiology and toxicology are examples of two fields that make contributions to exposure assessments and illuminate the adverse health effects associated with work related exposures among the adverse health outcomes that have been linked with the work environment are cancer respiratory illness and reproductive abnormalities unintentional injuries are one of the leading causes of work related morbidity and mortality but the psychological and social environment can also affect the health of workers by influencing levels of stress and morale methods have been developed to reduce exposures to hazards and increase occupational safety through redesign of the work environment introduction of engineering controls and limiting exposures to physical microbial and chemical agents

the main approach of most chapters is to examine occupational health issues and concerns from the standpoint of clinical presentations of the different organ systems e g respiratory disorders musculoskeletal disorders dermatological disorders the book also

contains chapters on screening and routine medical examinations health promotion at the workplace assessment of disability for compensation medical planning and management of industrial disasters and the prevention of occupational diseases further case studies have been incorporated in the chapters to make clear the relevant issues

occupational health practice is a comprehensive account of the practice of protecting and improving the health of people at work with some emphasis on the special needs of workers in developing countries topics covered by this book include the functions of an occupational health service special examinations in occupational medicine uses and methods of epidemiology and ergonomics the mental health of people at work prevention of occupational disease and ethics in occupational health practice are also discussed this book is comprised of 22 chapters and begins by outlining national developments in occupational medicine along with the different forms of service provided by private enterprise and the state the factors that influence a nation or an industrial organization to pay attention to the health of people at work are also considered the discussion then turns to the importance of health to one's work the functions of an occupational health service and prevention of accidents and occupational disease methods used in the study of groups of workers are described in sections on epidemiology field surveys and the collection and handling of sickness absence data the text also looks at ergonomics occupational hygiene and ethics and education in occupational health this monograph will be useful to physicians hygienists nurses and safety officers working in the field of occupational health to those whose interests encompass occupational health but cannot attend a course and to medical and non medical specialists in related fields

this new edition of occupational and environmental medicine concentrates more on the newer kinds of occupational disease including those like rsi and pesticide poisoning where exposure and effects are difficult to understand there is specific emphasis on work health and wellbeing with links to public health health promotion the value of work disabled people at work the aging workforce vocational rehabilitation evidence based practice and further chapters on the health effects of climate change and of occupational health and safety in relation to migration and terrorism

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
