robert thorne coryndon born in south africa in 1870 served twenty eight years as the top ranking administrator of african dependencies a career unmatched by any other british colonial governor governors were expected through a combination of good sense and good character to exercise rule over dependent peoples in an honest and impartial manner an amalgam of liberal values and autocratic methods which lent a certain ambiguity to british imperial rule in africa and elsewhere during his rule in barotseland 1897 1907 under cecil rhodes british south africa company coryndon confronted the problems of establishing a colonial regime in 1914 1915 during the last seven years of his swaziland appointment he served as chairman of the land commission that delineated the boundaries of african reserves in southern rhodesia as governor of uganda during a time of rapid economic expansion 1917 1922 he set up legislative and executive councils and as governor of kenya 1922 1925 he formed local native councils as an experiment in indigenous administration this first full length study of coryndon is neither a traditional gubernatorial biography of a favoured son of the imperial school nor an ideological history of colonial oppression instead youé sets out to analyze coryndon s relationships with african rulers white settlers indian traders and metropolitan officials in order to assess the impact of his administrations on the territories he governed and to delineate the constraints on proconsular rule

this volume deals with the conquest and colonization of zimbabwe and the establishment of southern rhodesia from the beginnings of british involvement in bechuanaland to the death of cecil rhodes its emphasis is on the white invaders and its chief concern is white individuals their motives actions and influence on events the british south africa company and the irregularity of its financial and political operations are dealt with in detail keppel jones also discusses the

development in the midst of the indigenous population of an alien white society and state from their crude beginnings to their emergence in a form still recognizable today the reader is led to conclude that by 1902 southern rhodesia was already set on the road that would lead to the upheavals of the second half of the twentieth century the author examines the racial consciousness and prejudice of the white society and addresses an important question why did the imperial government grant a royal charter to the bsa company the facts show conclusively that the imperial government had little interest in central africa or care for its fate except when foreign competition appeared keppel jones also reveals the important role played by black troops employed by the company in suppressing the rebellions of 1896 7 for opposite reasons neither blacks nor whites have been willing to recognize this on the other hand the habit of the men on the spot of making and carrying out decisions without regard to their superiors in london is a commonplace of imperial history one of the main themes of the book is the tension between the unofficial imperialists straining at the leash and the colonial office struggling to hold them back rhodes and rhodesia is based on extensive use of public records mainly in the public record office london and the national archives of zimbabwe of collections of private papers and of contemporary published works arthur keppel jones is professor emeritus of history at queen s university

the statistics of immigration and passenger movement are included in the report on foreign commerce to 1895 and for 1893 1894 are also published separately

revised updated and still very relevant this book focuses on the centrality of the land question in the study of modern zimbabwean history it reviews previously published studies and introduces new material the study covers the genesis of the land segregation legislation in rhodesia the land apportionment act and the economic effects of the act land and mass nationalism between 1945 and 1965 the dispossession of the people in gazaland and the tangwena people by white settlers the lancaster house negotiations and land reform in the post independence period the book further discusses the many theories of racism and segregation propounded by the defenders of the regime and the rationalisation for white rule and the economic exploitation of people and land
