available for the first time in ebook a new york times notable book on the eve of his ninetieth birthday a bachelor decides to give himself a wild night of love with a virgin as is his habit he has purchased hundreds of women he asks a madam for her assistance the fourteen year old girl who is procured for him is enchanting but exhausted as she is from caring for siblings and her job sewing buttons she can do little but sleep yet with this sleeping beauty at his side it is he who awakens to a romance he has never known tender knowing and slyly comic memories of my melancholy whores is an exquisite addition to the master s work

american photographer lee friedlander b 1934 has had an expansive career photographing his subjects from family and friends to political figures and celebrities in their everyday environments while simultaneously changing the very landscape of his chosen media in his human clay series images of people in their surroundings are presented together thematically each book features hundreds of photographs many never before published chosen and sequenced by the artist himself from his vast archive this latest volume in the series compiles some of friedlander s street photography taken over the course of more than 50 years including images of atlanta buffalo denver los angeles miami new orleans and san francisco as well as more than 125 photographs of new york city

gabriel garcía márquez is latin america s most internationally famous and successful author and a winner of the nobel prize his oeuvre of great modern novels includes one hundred years of solitude and love in the time of cholera his name has become closely associated with magical realism a phenomenon that has been immensely influential in world literature this companion includes new and probing readings of all of garcía márquez s works by leading international specialists his life in colombia the context of latin american history and culture key themes in his works and their critical reception are explored in detail written for students and readers of garcía márquez the companion is accessible for non spanish speakers and features a chronology and a guide to further reading this insightful and lively book will provide an invaluable framework for the further study and enjoyment of this major figure in world literature

the latin american novel burst onto the international literary scene with the boom era led by

julio cortázar gabriel garcía Márquez carlos fuentes and mario vargas llosa and has influenced writers throughout the world ever since garcía Márquez and vargas llosa each received the nobel prize in literature and many of the best known contemporary novelists are inspired by the region's fiction indeed magical realism the style associated with garcía Márquez has left a profound imprint on african american african asian anglophone caribbean and latinx writers furthermore post boom literature continues to garner interest from the novels of roberto bolaño to the works of César Aira and chico buarque to those of younger novelists such as juan gabriel Vásquez alejandro zambra and valeria luiselli yet for many readers the latin american novel is often read in a piecemeal manner delinked from the traditions authors and social contexts that help explain its evolution the oxford handbook of the latin american novel draws literary historical and social connections so that readers will come away understanding this literature as a rich and compelling canon in forty five chapters by leading and innovative scholars the handbook provides a comprehensive introduction helping readers to see the region's intrinsic heterogeneity for only with a broader view can one fully appreciate garcía Márquez or bolaño this volume charts the literary tradition of the latin american novel from its beginnings during colonial times its development during the nineteenth and the first half of the twentieth century and its flourishing from the 1960s onward furthermore the handbook explores the region's representations of identity narrative trends and authors that make this literature so diverse and fascinating reflecting on the latin american novel's position in world literature

this handbook offers a comprehensive examination of gabriel garcía Márquez's life oeuvre and legacy the first such work since his death in 2014 it incorporates ongoing critical approaches such as feminism ecocriticism marxism and ethnic studies while elucidating key aspects of his work such as his caribbean colombian background his use of magical realism myth and folklore and his left wing political views thirty two wide ranging chapters cover the bulk of the author's writings giving special attention to the global influence of garcía Márquez

by the turn of the twentieth century japan's military and economic successes made it the dominant power in east asia drawing hundreds of thousands of chinese korean and taiwanese students to the metropole and sending thousands of japanese to other parts of east asia the constant movement of peoples ideas and texts in the japanese empire created numerous literary contact nebulae fluid spaces of diminished hierarchies where writers grapple with and transculture one another's creative output drawing extensively on vernacular sources in japanese chinese and korean this book analyzes the most active of

these contact nebulae semicolonial chinese occupied manchurian and colonial korean and taiwanese transculturations of japanese literature it explores how colonial and semicolonial writers discussed adapted translated and recast thousands of japanese creative works both affirming and challenging japan s cultural authority such efforts not only blurred distinctions among resistance acquiescence and collaboration but also shattered cultural and national barriers central to the discourse of empire in this context twentieth century east asian literatures can no longer be understood in isolation from one another linked only by their encounters with the west but instead must be seen in constant interaction throughout the japanese empire and beyond

this book explores the relationship between psychoanalysis literary criticism and contemporary literature focusing on latin america and using examples from brazilian colombian chilean puerto rican and mexican literature it provides an important account of why gendered violence occurs and how it is portrayed in the novels discussed the protagonists express similar fears passions and illnesses that are present in contemporary latin america psychoanalysis and literary criticism offer us an interpretative framework to understand these voices especially those that are in the margin women particularly as part of a globalized labor force express through their bodies social problems that range from the erotic use of the body in a hypersexualized world to the body as a receptacle of violence that expresses the death drive this book is a fascinating contribution to literary gender and cultural studies

in puta life juana maría rodíguez probes the ways that sexual labor and latina sexuality become visual phenomena drawing on state archives illustrated biographies documentary films photojournalistic essays graphic novels and digital spaces she focuses on the figure of the puta the whore that phantasmatic figure of latinized feminine excess rodíguez s eclectic archive features the faces and stories of women whose lives have been mediated by sex work s stigmatization and criminalization washerwomen and masked wrestlers porn stars and sexiles rodíguez examines how visual tropes of racial and sexual deviance expose feminine subjects to misogyny and violence attuning our gaze to how visual documentation shapes perceptions of sexual labor throughout this poignant and personal text rodíguez brings the language of affect and aesthetics to bear upon understandings of gender age race sexuality labor disability and migration highlighting the criminalization and stigmatization that surrounds sex work she lingers on those traces of felt possibility that might inspire more ethical forms of relation and care

en el olor de las almendras amargas una buena parte de la obra de gabriel garcía márquez ha sido sometida a una mirada escrutadora desde la medicina forense y la criminalística para extraer con precisión quirúrgica cada fragmento que el autor colombiano ha narrado en relación con muertes violentas lesiones físicas no letales transgresiones éticas o las profundas motivaciones de las conductas delictivas que se exploran y las investigaciones judiciales o su ausencia a las que estas son sometidas en uno y otro libro al proponer una mirada fuera de lo común en la que convergen la literatura y la medicina legal sin duda esta obra es una novedosa invitación a releer con otros ojos la obra del nobel de literatura

the museum of bioprospecting intellectual property and the public domain addresses one of the most pressing policy issues of our day intellectual property rights versus the public domain in facilitating access to genetic resources for biotechnology development the issue is examined in the context of a proposal submitted by seven fictional scholars to an imaginary octogenarian whose humor provides an original addition to the discussion

at present the bulk of the existing research on sex trafficking originates in the social sciences sex trafficking in postcolonial literature adds an original perspective on this issue by examining representations of sex trafficking in postcolonial literature this book is a sustained interdisciplinary study bridging postcolonial literature in english and spanish and sex trafficking as analyzed through literary theory anthropology sociology history trauma theory journalism and globalization studies it encompasses postcolonial theory and literature s aesthetic analysis of sex trafficking together with research from social sciences psychology anthropology and economics with the intention of offering a comprehensive analysis of the topic beyond the type of orientalist discourse so prevalent in the media this is an important and innovative resource for scholars in literature postcolonial studies gender studies human rights and global justice

in the decade from the early 1960s to the early 1970s latin american authors found

themselves writing for a new audience in both latin america and spain and in an ideologically charged climate as the cold war found another focus in the cuban revolution the writers who emerged in this energized cultural moment among others julio cortázar argentina guillermo cabrera infante cuba josé donoso chile carlos fuentes mexico gabriel garcía márquez colombia manuel puig argentina and mario varas llosa peru experimented with narrative forms that sometimes bore a vexed relation to the changing political situations of latin america this volume provides a wide range of options for teaching the complexities of the boom explores the influence of boom works and authors presents different frameworks for thinking about the boom proposes ways to approach it in the classroom and provides resources for selecting materials for courses
