in the telling of the history of the church missionary society cms in tanzania the initiatives contributions and experiences of indigenous teachers have too often been neglected in favour of stories of sacrifices of western missionaries bishop mwita akiri redresses this bias by using a socio historical approach written from an afro centric tradition to evaluate the contributions and experiences of indigenous agents in the growth of christianity in tanzania this book underscores the significance of oral tradition in african historiography and challenges the claim that foreign missionaries succeeded in destroying african cultures when they are in fact alive and well this much needed research also provides a model for dialogue between the perspective of christian missions and that of african religious and social heritage in order to continue forward with a christianity that is authentic and also distinctly african

this edited volume provides the follow up to erling et al s 2021 multilingual learning and language supportive pedagogies in sub saharan africa the strategies put forward in volume 1 included multilingual pedagogies that allow students to draw on their full linguistic repertoires translanguaging and other language supportive pedagogies while there is great traction in the pedagogical strategies proposed in volume 1 limited progress has been made in terms of multilingual education in sub saharan africa ssa thus the main focus of this follow up volume is to explore the question of why former colonial languages and monolingual approaches continue to be used as the dominant languages of education even when we have multilingual pedagogies and materials that could and do work and despite substantial evidence that learners have difficulties when taught in a language they do not understand this book offers perspectives to answer this question through focusing on the internal and external pressures which impact the capacity for implementing multilingual strategies in educational contexts at regional national and community levels chapters provide insights into how to better understand and work within these contemporary constraints and challenge dominant monoglossic discourses which inhibit the implementation of multilingual education in ssa the volume focuses on three main areas which have proven to be stumbling blocks to the effective implementation of multilingual education to date namely assessment ideology and policy an insightful collection that will be of great interest to academics researchers and practitioners in the fields of language education language in education policy and educational assessments in the wide range of multilingual contexts in africa

nearly four decades ago terence ranger questioned to what extent african history was actually african and whether methods and concerns derived from western historiography were really sufficient tools for researching and narrating african

history despite a blossoming and branching out of africanist scholarship in the last twenty years that question is still haunting the most prestigious locations for production of african studies are outside africa itself and scholars still seek a solution to this paradox they agree that the ideal solution would be a flowering of institutions of higher learning within africa which would draw not only africanist scholars but also financial resources to the continent while the focus of this volume is on historical knowledge the effort to make african scholarship more african is fundamentally interdisciplinary the essays in this volume employ several innovative methods in an effort to study africa on its own terms the book is divided into four parts part 1 africanizing african history offers several diverse methods for bringing distinctly african modes of historical discourse to the foreground in academic historical research part 2 african creative expression in context presents case studies of african art literature music and poetry it attempts to strip away the exotic or primitivist aura such topics often accumulate when presented in a foreign setting in order to illuminate the social historical and aesthetic contexts in which these works of art were originally produced part 3 writing about colonialism demonstrates that the study of imperialism in africa remains a springboard for innovative work which takes familiar ideas about africa and considers them within new contexts part 4 scholars and their work critically examines the process of african studies itself including the roles of scholars in the production of knowledge about africa this timely and thoughtful volume will be of interest to african studies scholars and students who are concerned about the ways in which africanist scholarship might become more african
