this book offers a new account of the transitive particle verb construction in english the main emphasis is on the alternation between the two word orders possible in english continuous hand in the manuscript vs discontinuous hand the manuscript in the central aim is to show that the choice of the word order is not optional as has often been claimed in related literature on the topic and that a syntactic analysis should thus not be based on optional movement operations or optional feature selection the author argues in some detail that the choice of the word order is determined to a great extent by the information structuring of the context in which the relevant construction is embedded the syntactic structure she develops is based on a substantial combination of empirical facts evidence from theoretical research and the results of two experimental studies on the intonation patterns of the construction

syntax is the study of how words and phrases are arranged to form sentences syntax is an essential part of any language as it allows speakers and writers to communicate their ideas clearly and effectively in addition syntax also reveals the structure and logic of a language therefore mastering a language is impossible without learning the syntax of that language learning syntax is especially important for students of english major or for anyone who wants to master the english language english syntax is rich and complex with many rules and exceptions that govern its usage by understanding the basic principles and patterns of english syntax students can improve all their language skills reading writing speaking and listening skills in this book we will introduce you to the main concepts and topics of english syntax such as lexical categories the different types of words in english such as nouns verbs adjectives adverbs etc grammatical functions the roles that words and phrases play in a sentence such as subject object predicate modifier etc phrase structure rules the rules that determine how words and phrases can be combined to form larger units such as noun phrases verb phrases prepositional phrases etc syntactic tree diagrams the graphical representations of the

hierarchical structure and relationships of words and phrases in a sentence
transformational rules the rules that allow sentences to be changed or derived from other sentences such as passive voice questions formation negation etc

andrew radford s new textbook is principally for students with little or no background in syntax who need a lively and up to date introduction to contemporary work on transformational grammar it covers four main topics the goals of linguistic theory syntactic structure the nature and role of the lexicon and the function of transformations and the principles governing their application the framework takes into account the major works such as chomsky s knowledge of language and barriers written since the publication of radford s widely acclaimed transformational syntax in 1981 not only does the present book use a more recent theoretical framework but at the descriptive level it covers a wider range of constructions and rules than its predecessor andrew radford is well known for his effective pedagogical approach and in this book even more care has been devoted to providing a sympathetic and non technical introduction to the field at the end of each chapter are exercises which reinforce the text enable students to apply the various concepts etc discussed or encourage them to look more critically at some of the assumptions and analyses presented the book also has a detailed bibliographical background section and an extensive bibliography which will be a useful source of reference to the primary literature although intended principally as a coursebook for students of syntax or english grammar transformational grammar will be invaluable to any reader who needs a straightforward and

comprehensive introduction to the latest developments in this field

this textbook introduces basic concepts of grammar in a format which should encourage readers to use linguistic arguments it focuses on syntactic analysis and evidence it also looks at sociolinguistic and historical reasons behind prescriptive rules

this well illustrated book outlines a framework for the analysis of syntactic structure from a perspective of a systematic functional grammar in part the book goes back to the grammar's scale and category roots but now with the aim of presenting how a descriptive framework illustrating how the analysis of the syntactic structure can reflect the meaning structure the contents are divided into four sections section one gives a brief overview of systematic grammar including the linguistic system context of situation and language functions developing the lexicogrammar section two considers formal units and their classes but the principal focus is on section three which covers the role of units as elements of structure section four discusses areas of structural complexity and concludes with several refinements to the analysis format

an invaluable glossary of significant language and linguistic terms and concepts designed for students of English language and linguistics the book also provides a very useful overview of the subject as well as covering principal figures in linguistic criticism and their contribution to the subject organized into the core subject areas of language and linguistics it enables the reader to contextualize each particular definition and gain a wider understanding of each topic this edition has been updated to include more extensive coverage particularly of language terms

in this book the development of the English dictionary is examined along with the kinds of dictionary available the range of information they contain factors affecting their usage and public attitudes towards them as well as an descriptive analysis of word meaning the author considers whether a thematic thesaurus like presentation might be more suited than the traditional alphabetical format to the description of words and their meaning
