this book based on extensive field research examines the indian state s response to the multiple insurgencies that have occurred since independence in 1947 in reacting to these various insurgencies the indian state has employed a combined approach of force dialogue accommodation of ethnic and minority aspirations and overtime the state has established a tradition of negotiation with armed ethnic groups in order to bolster its legitimacy based on an accommodative posture while these efforts have succeeded in resolving the mizo insurgency it has only incited levels of violence with regard to others within this backdrop of ongoing indian counter insurgency this study provides a set of conditions responsible for the groundswell of insurgencies in india and some recommendations to better formulate india s national security policy with regard to its counter insurgency responses the study focuses on the national institutions responsible for formulating india s national security policy dealing with counter insurgency such as the prime minister s office the cabinet committee on security the national security council the ministry of home affairs and the indian military apparatus furthermore it studies how national interests and values influence the formulation of this policy and the overall success and or failure of the policy to deal with armed insurgent movements

notably the study traces the ideational influence of kautilya and gandhi in india s overall response to insurgencies multiple cases of armed ethnic insurgencies in assam manipur mizoram and nagaland in the northeast of india and the ideologically oriented maoist or naxalite insurgency affecting the heartland of india are analysed in depth to evaluate the indian counter insurgency experience this book will be of much interest to students of counter insurgency asian politics ethnic conflict and security studies in general

this book explores how unconventional warfare tactics have opposed governments from eighteenth century guerrilla warfare to contemporary urban terrorism the tactics of guerrilla leaders such as lawrence mao guevara and marighela are examined and the works of counter insurgency theorists such as galleni callwell thompson and kitson are analysed

in mobility mobilization and counter insurgency daniel agbibo takes african insurgencies back to their routes by providing a transdisciplinary perspective on the centrality of mobility to the strategies of insurgents state security forces and civilian populations caught in conflict drawing on one of the world s deadliest insurgencies the boko haram insurgency in northeast nigeria and the lake chad region this well crafted and richly nuanced intervention offers fresh insights into how violent extremist organizations exploit forms of local immobility and border porosity to mobilize new recruits how the state s war on terror mobilizes against so called subversive mobilities and how civilian populations in transit are treated as could be terrorists and subjected to extortion and state sanctioned violence en route the multiple and intersecting flows analyzed here upend eurocentric representations of movement in africa as one sided anarchic and dangerous instead this book underscores the contradictions of mobility in conflict zones as simultaneously a resource and a burden intellectually rigorous yet clear engaging and accessible mobility mobilization and counter insurgency is a seminal contribution that lays bare the neglected linkages between conflict and mobility

years after the u s invasion of iraq a loosely organized insurgency continues to target american and coalition soldiers as well as iraqi security forces and civilians with devastating results in this sobering account of the ongoing violence ahmed hashim a specialist on middle eastern strategic issues and on irregular warfare reveals the insurgents behind the widespread revolt their motives and their tactics the insurgency he shows is not a united movement directed by a leadership with a single ideological vision instead it involves former regime loyalists iraqis resentful of foreign occupation foreign and domestic islamist extremists and elements of organized crime these groups have cooperated with one another in the past and coordinated their attacks but the alliance between nationalist iraqi insurgents on the one hand and religious extremists has frayed considerably the u s led offensive to retake fallujah in november 2004 and the success of the elections for the iraqi national assembly in january 2005 have led more mainstream insurgent groups to begin thinking of reinforcing the political arm of their opposition movement and to seek political guarantees for the sunni arab community in the new iraq hashim begins by placing the iraqi revolt in its historical context he next profiles the various insurgent groups detailing their origins aims and operational and tactical modi operandi he concludes with an unusually candid assessment of the successes and failures of the coalition s counter insurgency campaign looking ahead hashim warns that ethnic and sectarian groups may soon be pitted against one another in what will be a fiercely contested fight over who gets what in the new iraq evidence that such a conflict is already developing does not augur well for iraq s future stability both iraq and the united states must work hard to ensure that slow but steady success over the insurgency is not overshadowed by growing ethno sectarian animosities as various groups fight one another for the biggest slice of the political and economic pie in place of sensational headlines official triumphalism and hand wringing insurgency and counter insurgency in iraq offers a clear eyed analysis of the increasingly complex violence that threatens the very future of iraq

beginning with britain s 1948 declaration of a malayan emergency and ending with the 1973 withdrawal of us ground troops from vietnam this handbook connects ideas about contested decolonization and the insurgencies that inspired it with an analysis of patterns and singularities in the conflicts that precipitated the collapse of overseas empires

insurgency and counterinsurgency in the nineteenth century examines insurgency and counterinsurgency across the globe in the nineteenth century the volume includes chapters from distinguished and rising historians from europe north and south america and covers irregular wars in spain ireland france latin america china usa africa central asia and burma the authors explore links between insurgencies and nationalism including learning curves and emulation in counterinsurgency with a special emphasis on non western warfare this volume includes case studies such as the katanga and white lotus rebellions largely unknown to western readers the military history of the nineteenth century thus reveals much more than the symmetrical warfare of napoleon grant and moltke this volume shows the commonalities of responses more than their differences and refracts these through themes which crop up repeatedly in different times and places these themes include common problems and solutions the challenge of commanding local intelligence networks public opinion millenarianism magic and religion technology hearts and minds the legal framework of state violence racial stereotypes and patterns of forgetting and remembering guerrilla conflicts the first recent study to examine western and non western warfare in equal measure stressing the prevalence of commonalities between guerrilla warfare and counterinsurgency across the

globe insurgency and counterinsurgency in the nineteenth century will be of great interest to scholars of military and strategic studies as well as modern military history it was originally published as a special issue of small wars insurgencies

this book seeks to answer the why and how questions about the insurgency of the pkk a militant left wing group of turkey s kurds in turkey the pkk has been inter locked in an intermittent war against turkey since 1984 in the name of kurdish nationalism the author combines insights of strategy and ir from strategy and tactics in irregular warfare to peace negotiations between state authorities and insurgents with data from qualitative research to achieve two inter related objectives first assess the current state of affairs and predict the future course of the conflict and secondly draw general conclusions on how protracted conflicts can end and how

this edited collection examines the british way in counter insurgency it brings together and consolidates new scholarship on the counter insurgency associated with the end of empire foregrounding a dark and violent history of british imperial rule one that stretched back to the nineteenth century and continued until the final collapse of the british empire in the 1960s the essays gathered in the collection cover the period from the late nineteenth century to the 1960s they are both empirical and conceptual in tone this edited collection pivots on the

theme of the nature of the force used by Britain against colonial insurgents it argues that the violence employed by British security forces in counter insurgency to maintain imperial rule is best seen from a maximal perspective contra traditional arguments that the British used minimum force to defeat colonial rebellions case studies are drawn from across the British empire covering a period of some hundred years but they concentrate on the savage wars of decolonisation after 1945 the collection includes a historiographical essay and one on the lost Hanslope archive by the scholar chosen by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office to manage the release of the papers held this book was published as a special issue of *Small Wars and Insurgencies*

this book is primarily an effort to study the phenomenon called insurgency that has been posing a huge challenge to the internal security of the country though a wealth of literature on the subject already exists a need was felt to analyse the multiple facets of insurgency as no country barring India has witnessed this endemic for a prolonged period the subject is so vast and dynamic that no strait jacketed solution can be prescribed to curb this menace overnight however an attempt has been made to analyse this phenomenon and prescribe remedial antidotes the author has attempted to capture the origin of insurgency which dates back to a late 18th century and study various causes and numerous factors that fuel it in addition he has also attempted to study the doctrines and strategies with special emphasis on both Islamic insurgency and other forms of uprisings in the country that continue to pose challenges to the Indian security environment owing allegiance to his uniform the author has also attempted to bring out the role of air power in counterinsurgency operations the penultimate chapter deals with shaping a viable counter insurgency strategy and spells out the essential parameters principles and pitfalls of such a strategy the chapter also dwells on the political aim and the importance of a socio economic turnabout to scale down insurgency the use of calibrated force rather than brutal armed suppressive methods is advocated will

insurgencies ever end this lingering question is discussed in the final chapter and certain essential strategies both military and non military are spelt out which would provide occasions and opportunities to forge a lasting solution to insurgency in india

this two volume history of counterinsurgency covers all the major and many of the lesser known examples of this widespread and enduring form of conflict addressing the various measures employed in the attempt to overcome the insurgency and examining the individuals and organizations responsible for everything from counterterrorism to infrastructure building how and when should counterinsurgency be pursued as insurgency is growing in frequency and conversely while conventional warfare continues to decline as a means by which political rivals seek to impose their will upon each other what lessons from the past should today s policymakers strategists military leaders and soldiers in the field keep in mind while facing off against 21st century insurgents this two volume set offers a comprehensive history of modern counterinsurgency covering the key examples of this widespread and enduring form of conflict it identifies the political military social and economic measures employed in attempting to overcome insurgency examining the work of the individuals and organizations involved demonstrating how success and failure dictated change from established policy and carefully analyzing the results readers will gain valuable insight from the detailed assessments of the history of counterinsurgency that demonstrate which strategies have succeeded and which have failed and why after an introductory essay on the subject each chapter provides historical background to the insurgency being addressed before focusing on the specific policies pursued and actions taken by the counterinsurgency force each section also provides an assessment of those operations including in most cases an analysis of lessons learned and where appropriate their relevance to counterinsurgency operations today the set s coverage spans modern counterinsurgencies from europe to asia to africa since 1900 and includes the ongoing counterinsurgency operations in afghanistan today its wide international

approach to the subject makes the set a prime resource for readers seeking specific information on a particular conflict or a better understanding of the general theories and practices of counterinsurgency

this book provides a historical study of the theory and praxis of modern insurgencies and counterinsurgencies coin modern insurgencies and counterinsurgencies a global history shows that the insurgents can wage a variety of conflicts at times conventional war which lies at the high end of their spectrum and terrorism which is located at the lowest end of their scale when insurgencies reach a certain critical threshold the insurgents shift their strategy from guerrilla irregular war to conventional regular war and at that point the level of conflict escalates to the level of civil war when the insurgents face intense state repression they revert to terrorist activities when the insurgents wage guerrilla war they can be called guerrillas the variety of wars conducted by the insurgents is termed as unconventional war this volume demonstrates that the insurgents in the modern world had been motivated by a trinity greed grievances and ideology kaushik roy traces the origin of modern insurgencies and coin from the sixteenth century by focusing on regions outside western eurasia he also touches on the twin interrelated phenomena of modern insurgencies and coin metastasising into something new at the beginning of the information revolution at the end of the twentieth century this volume will be of interest to researchers and research students of history british empire imperial studies asian studies security studies strategic studies and war and conflict studies
