the creation of writing centers in 712 schools and explains why the school library is the best place for the writing center there is a glaring absence of writing centers in today's K-12 schools more and more students are being asked in college entrance testing to submit samples of their writing and employers are expecting their workers to write correctly and clearly this book addresses the critical lack of writing centers below the undergraduate level it demonstrates how middle school and high school librarians can create writing centers in their school libraries explains how to assist students through a one on one writing tutorial method and gives students and teachers the tools for learning and understanding the complex art of writing author timothy horan inventor of the school library writing center establishes why school libraries represent the best and most logical places to create writing centers and why school librarians are the natural choice to direct writing center operations he then takes readers through the process of creating a writing center from original conception up through opening day additional topics covered include how to publicize and grow your school library writing center maintaining your writing center for efficient operation on a daily basis as well as for years to come how to become an effective writing center director and writing tutor the most current technology that can be used to assist in the writing composition and research process and working with english language learner ell students within your writing center

this book describes an innovative evidence based method for preparing students for the demands of college writing called supporting strategic writers ssw the goal of ssw is to help students become independent learners who understand the value of strategies and can apply them flexibly in future courses and the workplace the text provides genre based strategies for rhetorical analysis planning evaluation and revision critical reading of sources and synthesis of sources that are part of college composition and applicable across contexts and course assignments equally important to the ssw approach is that students learn metacognitive strategies for goal setting task management progress monitoring and reflection instructional methods include discussion of model essays think aloud modeling of strategies collaborative writing peer review and self evaluation and reflective journaling book features integrates three critical components strategies for critical reading and writing metacognitive strategies to help students take control of their learning and pedagogical strategies provides research based approaches for teaching developmental writing courses first year composition summer bridge programs and first year seminars offers thorough explanations of the strategies and instructional methods with practical examples and support materials for instructors based on two years of design research and three experimental studies which found significant positive effects on writing quality and motivation with college students in developmental writing courses

this book captures the diversity and richness of writing as it relates to different forms of abilities skills competencies and expertise psychologists educators researchers and practitioners in neighboring areas are interested in exploring how writing develops and in what manner this development can be fostered but they lack a handy unified and comprehensive source of information to satisfy their interest the goal of this book is to fill this void by reflecting on the phenomenon of writing from a developmental perspective it contains an integrated set of chapters devoted to issues of writing how writing develops how it is and should be taught and how writing paths of development differ across writing genres specifically the book addresses typologies of writing pathways of the development of writing skills stages of the development of writing individual differences in the acquisition of writing skills writing ability and disability teaching writing and the development and demonstration of expertise in writing

there are many how to books on writing for academics none of these however relate specifically to the discipline of geography in this book the author identifies the principle modes of academic writing that graduate students and early career faculty will encounter specifically focusing on those forms expected of geographers that is those modes that are reviewed by academic peers this book is readily accessible to senior undergraduate and graduate students and early career faculty who may feel intimidated by the process of writing this volume is not strictly a how to or step by step manual for writing an article or book rather through the use of real concrete examples from published and unpublished works the author demystifies the process of different types of scholarly pieces geographers have to write with the specific needs and challenges of the discipline in mind although chapters are thematic based e g stand alone chapters on book reviews articles and books the manuscript is structured around the concept of story telling for it is the author's contention that all writing whether a scientific study or more humanist essay is a form of story telling
