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winner 1990 berkshire conference book award art nouveau in fin de siecle france politics psychology and style explores the shift in the locus of modernity from technological monument to private interior it examines the political economic social intellectual and artistic factors specific to late 19th century france that interacted in the development of art nouveau winner 1990 berkshire

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rarely has a subject been served by a book of this stature five years in the making it covers all aspects of art nouveau in france in 624 authoritative pages and 740 illustrations arwas traces the evolution of the movement as it developed primarily in nancy and paris with the help of carefully chosen illustrations many never published before ranging from the 1900 paris exhibition to paintings graphics and posters and such collecting fields as furniture jewellery ceramics book bindings and sculpture the informative witty text ranges over architecture haute couture and the role of women in art nouveau with a particular look at such theatrical icons as sarah bernhardt lo e fuller and the grandes horizontales destined to become the standard book on the subject both content and design will appeal widely to the connoisseur the specialist and the collector as well as to the novice who will be introduced to the magical wonders of the style

first published in 1998 design reform in the fields of architecture and the decorative or applied arts became objectified through writings published during the period of 1885 to 1910 this investigation includes but is not limited to art nouveau in france and belgium and the arts and crafts movement in england and the united states even though the similar processes of creativity and shared goals of art nouveau and the arts and crafts movement have long been recognized attempts to explore their origins and their points of interrelation with the broader scope of art history have been largely unsuccessful until now

art nouveau was a style for a new age but it was also one that continued to look back to the past this new study shows how in expressing many of their most essential concerns sexuality death and the nature of art its artists drew heavily upon classical literature and the iconography of classical art it challenges the conventional view that art nouveau s adherents turned their backs on

classicism in their quest for new forms across europe and north america artists continued to turn back to the ancient world and in particular to greece for the vitality with which they sought to infuse their creations the works of many well known artists are considered through this prism including those of gustav klimt aubrey beadsley and louis comfort tiffany but breaking new ground in its comparative approach this study also considers some of the movement s less well known painters sculptors jewellers and architects including in central and eastern europe and their use of classical iconography to express new ideas of nationhood across the world while art nouveau was a plural style drawing on multiple influences the classics remained a key artistic vocabulary for its artists whether blended with orientalist and other iconographies or preserving the purity of classical form

577 authentic art nouveau designs ranging in size from full page illustrations to borders headpieces tailpieces and initials designs include florals landscapes and figures from artists such as klimt bradley auriol and larcombe

the first english collection of writings by henry van de velde one of the most influential designers and theorists of the twentieth century belgian artist architect designer and theorist henry van de velde 1863 1957 was a highly original and influential figure in europe beginning in the 1890s a founding member of the art nouveau and jugendstil movements he also directed the grand ducal saxon school of arts and crafts in weimar germany which eventually became the bauhaus under walter gropius this selection of twenty six essays translated from french and german includes van de velde s writings on william morris and the english arts and crafts movement neo impressionist painting and relationships between ornament line and abstraction in german aesthetics the texts trace the evolution of van de velde s thoughts during his most productive period as a theorist in the artistic debates in france germany belgium and the netherlands katherine m kuenzli expertly guides readers to see how van de velde s writings reconcile themes of aesthetics and function and expression and reason throughout the artistic periods and regions represented by these texts with introductory discussions of each essay and full annotations this is an essential volume for a broad range of scholars and students of the history of fine and applied arts and ideas

this book is the first full length study of the art and writings of jean delville as a member of the younger generation that emerged during the end of the nineteenth century he was a dynamic leader of a group of avant garde artists who sought to establish a new school of idealist art in belgium he was one of the most talented painters of his generation producing a vast body of works that in both scale and technical accomplishment is unsurpassed amongst his contemporaries in his extensive writings in contemporary journals and books he pursued a singular vision for the purpose of art to serve as a vehicle for social change as well as to inspire individuals to be drawn to a higher spiritual reality delvilles thinking is heavily indebted to the hermetic and esoteric philosophy that

was widely popular at the time and his paintings poetry and writings reformulate the main tenets of this tradition in a contemporary context in this regard his aesthetic and artistic goals are similar if not identical to those found in the writings and art of kandinsky and mondrian during the early twentieth century
