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in this brief and easy to read ivp booklet c baxter kruger vividly retells the parable of the prodigal son including the full text of luke 15 1 32 his fresh interpretation focuses not on the prodigal son but on the character of the father as it is revealed through his interaction with his two very different sons baxter asks you to consider with which son you most identify the dutiful elder brother or the wayward younger brother then he helps you explore the spiritual implications of that identification finally he shows you how an examination of the father of the two sons highlights important aspects of god s character rejoicing compassion and more you ll

come away from this short but profound study with new insight into the ways god the father is at work in your own life

perhaps no other group of people has been as much formed by biblical texts and tropes as african americans from literature and the arts to popular culture and everyday life the bible courses through black society and culture like blood through veins despite the enormous recent interest in african american religion relatively little attention has been paid to the diversity of ways in which african americans have utilized the bible african americans and the bible is the fruit of a four year collaborative research project directed by vincent l wimbush and funded by the lilly endowment it brings together scholars and experts sixty eight in all from a wide range of academic and artistic fields and disciplines including ethnography cultural history and biblical studies as well as art music film dance drama and literature the focus is on the interaction between the people known as african americans and that complex of visions rhetorics and ideologies known as the bible as such the book is less about the meanings of the bible than about the bible and meanings less about the worlds of the bible than about how worlds and the bible interact in short about how a text constructs a people and a people constructs a text it is about a particular sociocultural formation but also about the dynamics that obtain in the interrelation between any group of people and sacred texts in general thus african americans and the bible provides an exemplum of sociocultural formation and a critical lens through which the process of sociocultural formation can be viewed
