since the second century 1 2 timothy and titus often referred to as the pastoral epistles have been read and practiced together to help order a christian congregation s life and mission these three letters were likely recognized early on as divinely inspired scripture and were added to the pauline collection to help train the spiritual leaders of earliest christianity however they are rarely taught in most congregations and seminaries today admittedly the genre of these letters paraenesis is hard to preach the primary reason for their neglect however is modern criticism s silencing of them because most scholars think they were not written by paul and are not aligned with either his gospel or mission moreover they include instructions that are widely received today as out of sync with our modern social worlds this proclamation commentary on these pauline letters presumes both their apostolic authority as divinely inspired and human inspiring scripture and their contemporary relevance in encouraging clergy and teachers to reimagine their roles as ministers of the gospel and spiritual leaders for today s global church

this book presents a new set of ideas to challenge established thinking and to guide researching and designing teacher professional development grounded in the work of the learning4teaching project which documented public sector teachers experiences and learning from professional development in three countries the volume presents a sociomaterial perspective on teacher sensemaking this teacher centered perspective disputes the conventional calculus in which teachers learn content that they apply in their classrooms part i outlines conventional issues in how teacher learning and professional development have been conceptualized and studied part ii introduces a new group of concepts that rethink these assumptions and part iii offers important insights to inform professional development across disciplines cultures and contexts written by a leading international teacher educator in an accessible style that incorporates visual representations and project data the book will appeal to practitioners scholars and researchers who design and research how teachers learn in professional development

a comprehensive selection of texts central to the kadam lineage of tibetan buddhism including topics like mind training stages of the path and esoteric tantric instructions the treasury of precious instructions by jamgön kongtrul lodrö taye one of tibet s greatest buddhist masters is a shining jewel of tibetan literature presenting essential teachings from the entire spectrum of practice lineages that existed in tibet in its eighteen volumes kongtrul brings together some of the most important texts on key topics of buddhist thought and practice as well as authoring significant new sections of his own the kadam lineage derives from the teachings and practices taught by the indian master atīśa and his tibetan students atīśa spent twelve years in tibet and left a scholarly and devotional lineage that would be significant to all traditions of tibetan buddhism but particularly the geluk the tradition of the dalai lamas which fashioned themselves as the new kadam tradition jamgön kongtrul s catalog to the treasury of precious instructions classifies kadam literature into five categories treatise instruction esoteric practice ancillary works and associated works the first two are the main topics covered in this volume lamrim or stages of the path and lojong or mind training these two kadam teachings continue to exert a significant influence on tibetan buddhism and therefore represent the legacy of the kadam tradition the first centers around the lamp for the path to enlightenment written by the eleventh century indian master atīśa who spent twelve years in tibet and this volume also includes stories of atīśa s life and travels the second set of teachings consists of aphorisms known as the seven point mind training meant to be used as contemplative practices to develop compassion and transform the mind these selections show not only the foundational texts of the kadam tradition but also the widespread impact these teachings continued to have across traditions
