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in becoming confederates gary w gallagher explores loyalty in the era of the civil war focusing on robert e lee stephen dodson ramseur and jubal a early three prominent officers in the army of northern virginia who became ardent confederate nationalists loyalty was tested and proved in many ways leading up to and during the war looking at levels of allegiance to their native state to the slaveholding south to the united states and to the confederacy gallagher shows how these men represent responses to the mid nineteenth century crisis lee traditionally has been presented as a reluctant convert to the confederacy whose most powerful identification was with his home state of virginia an interpretation at odds with his far more complex range of loyalties ramseur the youngest of the three eagerly embraced a confederate identity highlighting generational differences in the equation of loyalty early combined elements of lee s and ramseur s reactions a unionist who grudgingly accepted virginia s departure from the united states but later came to personify defiant confederate nationalism the paths of these men toward confederate loyalty help delineate important contours of american history gallagher shows that americans juggled multiple often conflicting loyalties and that white southern identity was preoccupied with racial control transcending politics and class indeed understanding these men s perspectives makes it difficult to argue that the confederacy should not be deemed a nation perhaps most important their experiences help us understand why confederates waged a prodigiously bloody war and the manner in which they dealt with defeat

you would be surprised to see what men we have in the ranks virginia cavalryman thomas rowland informed his mother in may 1861 just after joining the army of northern virginia his army general robert e lee s army was a surprise to almost everyone with daring early victories and an invasion into the north they nearly managed to convince the north to give up the fight even in 1865 facing certain defeat after the loss of 30 000 men a louisiana private fighting in lee s army still had hope i must not despair he scribbled in his diary lee will bring order out of chaos and with the help of our heavenly father all will be well astonishingly after 150 years of scholarship there are still some major surprises about the army of northern virginia in general lee s army renowned historian joseph t glatthaar draws on an impressive range of sources assembled over two decades from letters and diaries to

official war records to a new definitive database of statistics to rewrite the history of the civil war's most important army and indeed of the war itself. Glatthaar takes readers from the home front to the heart of the most famous battles of the war: Manassas, the Peninsula campaign, Antietam, Gettysburg, all the way to the final surrender at Appomattox. General Lee's army, its headquarters, tents, and winter shanties, eliciting the officers' plans, wishes, and prayers, it portrays a world of life, death, healing, and hardship. It investigates the South's commitment to the war and its gradual erosion, and it depicts and analyzes Lee's men in triumph and defeat. The history of Lee's army is a powerful lens on the entire war; the fate of Lee's army explains why the South almost won and why it lost. The story of his men, their reasons for fighting, their cohesion, mounting casualties, diseases, supply problems, and discipline problems, tells it all. Glatthaar's definitive account settles many historical arguments: the rebels were fighting, above all, to defend slavery; more than half of Lee's men were killed, wounded, or captured, a staggering statistic; their leader, Robert E. Lee, though far from perfect, held an exalted place in his men's eyes despite a number of mistakes and despite a range of problems among some of his key lieutenants. General Lee's army is a masterpiece of scholarship and vivid storytelling, narrated as much as possible in the words of the enlisted men and their officers.

Household War is a collection of essays that explores the civil war through the household. this book is the first to focus on america s talented enemies the generals admirals indian chiefs and warriors submarine captains fighter pilots and spies who opposed the united states with military force or other means often these military leaders were among the best minds of their times for more than two centuries the new nation s most constant military opponents were the native americans led by such capable chiefs as american horse and little wolf under d iberville canada s french colonialists became formidable foes but they were soon surpassed by the rigorously disciplined redcoats of great britain under howe and cornwallis ironically the most effective enemies in the history of the united states were not the leaders of foreign military forces like mexico s santa anna japan s yamamoto or vietnam s vo nguyen giap they arose from among its own citizens during the civil war the bloodiest conflict in american history

the importance of the civil war and reconstruction in the history of the united states cannot be overstated many historians regard the civil war as the defining event in american history at stake was not only freedom for 3 5 million slaves but also survival of the relatively new american experiment in self government a very real possibility existed that the union could have been severed but a collection of determined leaders and soldiers proved their willingness to fight for the survival of what abraham lincoln called the last best hope on earth the second edition of this highly readable one volume historical dictionary of the civil war and reconstruction looks to place the war in its historical context the more than 800 entries encompassing the years 1844 1877 cover the significant events persons politics and economic and social themes of the civil war and reconstruction an extensive chronology introductory essay and comprehensive bibliography supplement the cross referenced dictionary entries to guide the reader through the military and non military actions of one of the most pivotal events in american history the dictionary concludes with a selection of primary documents this book is an excellent access point for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about the civil war and reconstruction

roy herron graduated with highest honors from the university of tennessee at martin then studied new testament and ethics in scotland before earning divinity and law degrees from vanderbilt university but he came home to west tennessee and served the volunteer state in both the tennessee house and senate for four decades herron served as a legislator attorney teacher and methodist minister in that work he published op ed essays and articles in tennessee s leading newspapers and publications from the japan times to the wall street journal on various

topics including constitutional liberties economic justice health care politics and more this informative volume collects the most powerful of these writings adding helpful updates and contemporary insights with an engaging conversational style herron addresses voter id laws drunk driving statutes women s rights and many recurring contemporary issues whether describing the challenges facing his elderly mother as she attempted to exercise her right to vote or the struggles of working women and men facing illnesses without health insurance herron demonstrates an earnestness and thoughtfulness all too rare in politics these nearly fifty essays and articles provide evidence that herron s democratic party and christianity are not mutually exclusive indeed herron describes how faith brought him to politics and to fighting for justice jobs and constitutional freedoms for all citizens faith at work is a veritable guidebook on how faith and spirituality should affect decision making and advocacy in public life roy herron was a tennessee state representative from 1987 to 1997 and state senator from 1997 to 2013 he wrote things held dear soul stories for my sons and god and politics how can a christian be in politics he coauthored with cotton ivy tennessee political humor some of these jokes you voted for he lawyers and writes in west tennessee and nashville

cullman county was established in 1877 in large part from the west side of blount and the east side of winston counties today the few old cemeteries which existed in those counties in the early days are found within the borders of cullman the cemetery listings in this four volume set were conducted by the author beginning in 2003 and ending in early 2006 an attempt was made to personally visit every cemetery in cullman county and record information from each readable monument volume 1 of this series covers alphabetically cemeteries a through d beginning with the addington chapel cemetery and concluding with the duck river missionary baptist church cemetery the volumes are filled with photos of many of the old cemetery sites and notes describing the company and unit of most of the old civil war era veterans this set of books is vital to any serious student of cullman county genealogy and history
