already well known for his bestselling series of exposés on secret nazi technology and the survival of the third reich after the end of world war ii oxford educated historian and physicist joseph p farrell here delves ever deeper into the activities of this nefarious group in his previous works farrell has clearly demonstrated that the nazis were clandestinely developing new and amazing technologies toward the end of wwii and that the key scientists involved in these experiments were exported to the allied countries at the end of the conflict mainly the united states in a move called operation paperclip nasa director and developer of the saturn v rocket that sent americans to the moon werner von braun was one of these scientists farrell has traced the links between ongoing reich activities and the newly formed cia and other defense military industrial establishments now farrell has meticulously reviewed the best known roswell research from ufo et advocates and skeptics alike as well as some little known source material and comes to a radically different scenario of what happened in roswell new mexico in july 1947 and why the us military has continued to cover it up to this day farrell presents a fascinating case sure to disturb both et believers and disbelievers namely that what crashed may have been representative of an independent postwar nazi power an extraterritorial reich monitoring its old enemy america and the continuing development of the very technologies confiscated from germany at the end of the war

an exploration of the development of military theory and doctrine in the german army between the wars

princes philipp and christoph von hessen kassel great grandsons of queen victoria of england had been humiliated by defeat in world war i and like much of the german aristocracy feared the social unrest wrought by the ineffectual weimar republic jonathan petropoulos shows how the princes lured by prominent positions in the nazi regime and highly susceptible to nationalist appeals became enthusiastic supporters of hitler prince philipp son in law to the king of italy became the highest ranking prince in the nazi state and developed a close personal relationship with hitler and hermann göering prince christoph was a prominent ss officer and head of the most important intelligence agency in the third reich in return the princes made the nazis socially acceptable to wealthy high society patrons prince philipp even introduced göering to mussolini at a critical stage in the nazi party's development and later served as a liaison between hitler and the italian dictator permitted access to hessen family private papers and the royal archives at windsor castle petropoulos follows the story of

the house of hesse through to its tragic denouement the princes betrayal and persecution by an increasingly paranoid hitler and prosecution and denazification by the allies

between 1935 and 1940 the nazis incorporated large portions of europe into the german reich the contributors to this volume analyze the evolving anti jewish policies in the annexed territories and their impact on the jewish population as well as the attitudes and actions of non jews germans and indigenous populations they demonstrate that diverse anti jewish policies developed in the different territories which in turn affected practices in other regions and even influenced berlin s decisions having these systematic studies together in one volume enables a comparison based on the most recent research between anti jewish policies in the areas annexed by the nazi state the results of this prizewinning book call into question the common assumption that one central plan for persecution extended across nazi occupied europe shifting the focus onto differing regional german initiatives and illuminating the cooperation of indigenous institutions

the reichsbürger movement is at least in terms of public awareness a rather recent political phenomenon even though its roots go back at least as far as the 1970s this volume is the first to focus on the linguistic specifics of the reichsbürger movement adopting a politolinguistic perspective it analyses the peculiarities and strategies evident in the self presentation and especially in the propaganda of the reichsbürger central aspects of the reichsbürger worldview are analysed and deconstructed with regard to their linguistic representation these include for instance messages relating to violence war discourses conspiracy theories and pseudo religious references which are used in the scene to justify their fundamental rejection of the social and political reality of the federal republic of germany the study pays particular attention to the linguistic expression of reichsbürger identity not only looking at the self presentation of reichsbürger but also at how and with which linguistic means they attempt to obstruct state institutions and representatives

as a wwii tour director for thirty five years david harper has repeatedly heard the same questions from an extremely varied american and british audience why did the germans vote for hitler did they know about the concentration camps what did german soldiers and members of the ss feel about the extermination camps and the war crimes they were committing how do today s germans view hitler and the third reich what is the country doing at present to address those dark pages of its history and to remember the victims of hitler s regime do the right wing demonstrations

in germany portend a resurgence of nazi ideology today all these questions and many more are addressed in exposing the reich the book seeks to promote an understanding of how the devastation and tragedy of the war and the concurrent genocide could happen it studies the lethal blend of inciting hatred ongoing indoctrination justification for drastic action and the complete control of all media how many people know for instance that hitler was writing an opera when he lived in vienna or how he developed his antisemitic outlook while living there few know about the early political and ideological influences on hitler s worldview such as those instigated by his little known mentor eckart who has ever heard about hitler s second book in which he revealed his major foreign policy plans a manuscript that remained secret how many realize that hitler s regime planned on replacing christianity with its own religion and substituting mein kampf for the bible why did hitler name his regime the third reich and why did he choose the swastika as its logo why did the fine arts enjoy such an honored status during the reich what were the lesser known original purposes of the concentration camp system established in germany just weeks after hitler seized power who realizes that just prior to hitler seizing power the jewish population in germany was a mere 0.7% these and countless more insights regarding the third reich are revealed in exposing the reich from young students to well informed history buffs readers will gain a wealth of new insights into hitler and his regime of terror

germany and the holy roman empire offers a new interpretation of the development of german speaking central europe and the holy roman empire or german reich from the great reforms of 1495 1500 to its dissolution in 1806 after the turmoil of the french revolutionary and napoleonic wars going against the notion that this was a long period of decline joachim whaley shows how imperial institutions developed in response to the crises of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries notably the reformation and thirty years war and assesses the impact of

international developments on the reich central themes are the tension between habsburg aspirations to create a german monarchy and the desire of the german princes and cities to maintain their traditional rights and how the reich developed the functions of a state during this period the first single author account of german history from the reformation to the early nineteenth century since hajo holborn's study written in the 1950s it also illuminates the development of the german territories subordinate to the reich whaley explores the implications of the reformation and subsequent religious reform movements both protestant and catholic and the enlightenment for the government of both secular and ecclesiastical principalities the minor territories of counts and knights and the cities the reich and the territories formed a coherent and workable system and as a polity the reich developed its own distinctive political culture and traditions of german patriotism over the early modern period whaley explains the development of the holy roman empire as an early modern polity and illuminates the evolution of the several hundred german territories within it he gives a rich account of topics such as the reformation the thirty years war pietism and baroque catholicism the aufklärung or german enlightenment and the impact on the empire and its territories of the french revolution and napoleon it includes consideration of language cultural aspects and religious and intellectual movements germany and the holy roman empire engages with all the major debates among both german and english speaking historians about early modern german history over the last sixty years and offers a striking new interpretation of this important period volume i extends from the late fifteenth century through to the thirty years war

the third reich's elite schools tells the story of the napolas nazi germany's most prominent training academies for the future elite this deeply researched study gives an in depth account of everyday life at the schools while also shedding fresh light on the political social and cultural history of the nazi dictatorship

statistical tools were to provide the basis for a radical experiment in economic planning based on the german example this book presents the case for a more wide ranging reconsideration of the history of modern economic knowledge

red saxony throws new light on the reciprocal relationship between political modernization and authoritarianism in germany over the span of six decades election battles were fought so fiercely in imperial germany because they reflected two kinds of democratization social democratization could not be stopped but political democratization was opposed by many members of the german bourgeoisie frightened by the electoral success of the social democrats after 1871 anti democrats deployed many strategies that flew in the face of electoral fairness they battled socialists liberals and jews at election time but they also strove to rewrite the electoral rules of the game using a regional lens to rethink older assumptions about germany s changing political culture this volume focuses as much on contemporary germans perceptions of electoral fairness as on their experiences of voting it devotes special attention to various semi democratic voting systems whereby a general and equal suffrage for the reichstag was combined with limited and unequal ones for local and regional parliaments for the first time democratization at all three tiers of governance and their reciprocal effects are considered together although the bourgeois face of german authoritarianism was nowhere more evident than in the kingdom of saxony red saxony illustrates how other germans grew to fear the spectre of democracy certainly twists and turns lay ahead yet that fear made it easier for hitler and the nazis to win elections in the 1920s and to entomb german democracy in 1933

in this study author anthony j sciolino himself a catholic cuts into the heart of why the catholic church and christianity as a whole failed to stop the holocaust he demonstrates that nazism s racial anti semitism was rooted in christian anti judaism while tens of thousands of christians risked their lives to save jews many more including some members of the hierarchy aided hitler s campaign with their silence or their participation sciolino s research and interpretation provide an analysis of christian doctrine and church history to help answer the question of what went wrong he suggests that christian tradition and teaching systematically excluded jews from the circle of christian concern and thus led to the tragedy of the holocaust from the origins of anti judaism and anti semitism and the controversial position of pope pius xii to the catholic church s current endeavors to hold itself accountable for their role the holocaust the church and the law of unintended consequences offers an examination of one of

history's most disturbing issues

it is often argued that the unification of Germany in 1871 was the inevitable result of the convergence of Prussian power and German nationalism John Breuilly here shows that the true story was much more complex for most of the nineteenth century Austria was the dominant power in the region Prussian led unification was highly unlikely up until the 1860s and even then was only possible because of the many other changes happening in Germany Europe and the wider world

Naomi Kramer and Ronald Headland approach the universal issues that inevitably arise in discussing the Holocaust: evil, courage, human dignity, moral responsibility and the existential qualities of humankind through individual experience. Consisting of two main parts, the book explores one individual's experience during the Shoah and the historical context in which these experiences occurred. During World War II the Nazis plundered from occupied countries millions of items of incalculable value estimated in the hundreds of millions of dollars. Spearheaded by Hermann Goering, the looting program quickly created the largest private art collection in the world, exceeding the collections amassed by the Metropolitan in New York, the British Museum in London, the Louvre in Paris, and the Tretyakov Gallery in Moscow. By the end of the war, the Nazis had stolen roughly one-fifth of the entire art treasures of the world. This book explores the formation of the Nazi art collection and the methods used by Goering and his party to strip occupied Europe of a large part of its artistic heritage.

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
