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today some six million freemasons around the world continue to perform their rituals regularly an enormous legacy of spiritual endeavour kept largely in secret in britain alone there are over 7 000 lodges with a quarter of a million members what is this wealth this appeal and how did the philosopher and spiritual scientist rudolf steiner reinterpret or reconstruct freemasonry s time worn legacy unless one is a freemason the masonic world with its arcane conventions and language remains largely unknown an obscurity that is almost impossible to fathom yet understanding its traditions and style are invaluable when approaching goethe mozart herder lessing and novalis as well as rudolf steiner steiner himself renewed the royal art of freemasonry from 1906 to 1914 through his ritual work known as mystica Æterna when steiner invigorated education medicine the social order and religion he fully intended that committed and professional individuals should assume responsibility for the new initiatives but this was not the case with the masonic order he founded whose leadership he took upon himself even the celebration of his passing in 1925 led by marie steiner was entirely masonic in character in the context of continuing resistance and misrepresentation n v p franklin uncovers the living heart of freemasonry and reveals why it was and still is immensely relevant to anthroposophy with profound research into its older rituals and teachings this detailed and conscientious study is a unique contribution to comprehending freemasonry and anthroposophy both historically and in the present day

especially since the renaissance some in western christendom have suspected that the deeper dimension of their tradition has somehow been lost and have therefore sought to discover or create an esoteric or initiatic christianity in the middle of the nineteenth century two scholars gabriele rossetti and eugène aroux pointed to certain esoteric meanings in the work of dante alighieri notably the divine comedy partly based on their scholarship guénon in 1925 published the esoterism of dante from the theses of rosetti and aroux guénon retains only those elements that prove the existence of such hidden meanings but he also makes clear that esoterism is not heresy and that a doctrine reserved for an elite can be superimposed on the teaching given the faithful without standing in opposition to it one of rené guénon s lifelong quests was to discover or revive the esoteric initiatory dimension of the christian

tradition in the present volume along with its companion volume insights into christian esoterism which includes the separate study saint bernard gu  non undertakes to establish that the three parts of the divine comedy represent the stages of initiatic realization exploring the parallels between the symbolism of the commedia and that of freemasonry rosicrucianism and christian hermeticism and illustrating dante s knowledge of traditional sciences unknown to the moderns the sciences of numbers of cosmic cycles and of sacred astrology in these works gu  non also touches on the all important question of medieval esoterism and discusses the role of sacred languages and the principle of initiation in the christian tradition as well as such esoteric christian themes and organizations as the holy grail the guardians of the holy land the sacred heart the fedeli d amore and the courts of love and the secret language of dante in addition to dante various other paths toward a possible christian esoterism have been explored by many investigators the legend of the holy grail the knights templars the tradition of courtly love freemasonry rosicrucianism and christian hermeticism and gu  non deals with all of these in the present volume as well as his insights into christian esoterism in the latter one chapter in particular christianity and initiation will be of special interest with regard to the history of the traditionalist school when first published as an article it gave rise to some controversy because gu  non here reaffirmed his denial of the efficacy of the christian sacraments as rites of initiation a point of divergence between the teachings of gu  non and those of other key perennialist thinkers both the esoterism of dante and insights into christian esoterism will be of inestimable value to all who are struggling to come to terms with the fullness of the christian tradition

satie s music and ideas are inextricably linked with the city of light this book situates satie s work within the context and sonic environment of contemporary paris sunday times classical music book of the year erik satie s 1866 1925 music appeals to wide audiences and has influenced both experimental artists and pop musicians little about satie was conventional and he resists classification under easy headings such as classical music instead of pursuing the path of a professional composer satie initially earned a living as a café pianist and moved in bohemian circles which prized satire popular culture and experiment small wonder that his music is fundamentally new in conception it is music which is not always designed to be listened to attentively music which can be machine like but is to be played by humans for satie music was part of a wider concept of artistic creation as evidenced by his collaborations with leading avant garde artists and in works which cross traditional genre boundaries such as his texted piano pieces his music was created in some of the most exciting and creatively stimulating environments of the late nineteenth and early twentieth century

montmartre and montparnasse paris was the artistic centre of europe and satie was a notorious figure whose music and ideas are inextricably linked with the city of light this book situates satie s work within the context and sonic environment of contemporary paris it shows that the influence of street music musicians and poets interested in new technology contemporary innovations and radical politics are all crucial to an understanding of satie music from the ever popular gymnopédies to newly discovered works are discussed and an online supplement features rare pieces recorded especially for the book caroline potter is reader in music at kingston university london a graduate in both french and music she has published widely on french music since debussy and was series advisor to the philharmonia orchestra s paris 2014 15 season

how fin de siècle paris became the locus for the most intense revival of magical practices and doctrines since the renaissance examines the remarkable lives of occult practitioners joséphin peladan papus stanislas de guaita saint yves d alveydre jules doinel and others reveals how occult activity deeply influenced many well known cultural movements such as symbolism the decadents modern music and the psychedelic 60s during paris s belle Époque 1871 1914 many cultural movements and artistic styles flourished symbolism impressionism art nouveau the decadents all of which profoundly shaped modern culture inseparable from this cultural advancement was the explosion of occult activity taking place in the city of light at the same time exploring the magical artistic and intellectual world of the belle Époque tobias churton shows how a wide variety of theosophists rosicrucians martinists freemasons gnostics and neo cathars called fin de siècle paris home he examines the precise interplay of occultists joséphin peladan papus stanislas de guaita and founder of the modern gnostic church jules doinel along with lesser known figures such as saint yves d alveydre paul sédir charles barlet edmond bailly albert jounet abbé lacuria and lady caithness he reveals how the work of many masters of modern culture such as composers claudé debussy and erik satie writers arthur rimbaud and charles baudelaire and painters georges seurat and alphonse osbert bear signs of immersion in the esoteric circles that were thriving in paris at the time the author demonstrates how the creative hermetic ferment that animated the city of light in the decades leading up to world war i remains an enduring presence and powerful influence today where he asks would aleister crowley and all the magicians of today be without the parisian source of so much creativity in this field conveying the living energy of paris in

this richly artistic period of history churton brings into full perspective the characters personalities and forces that made paris a global magnet and which allowed later cultural movements such as the psychedelic 60s to rise from the ashes of post war europe

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
