too often new teachers enter the profession excited to make a difference in the lives of children only to find themselves disillusioned and overwhelmed with the expectations of the classroom in a sense of belonging jennifer allen shares her stories and journey in creating an infrastructure of support for new teachers within her school district a sense of belonging provides research based practical ideas on how to support new teachers while honoring the innovation idealism and optimistic enthusiasm that they bring to the classroom from supporting new teachers early in the year with administering and analyzing literacy assessments through using student work to guide instruction to offering ongoing help with curriculum planning jennifer shares strategies on fostering relationships with new teachers starting before school even begins creating learning environments for new teachers to be reflective practitioners coaching new teachers in their classrooms and providing opportunities for them to observe their peers in action supporting new teachers beyond their first year through gradual release of support over their first several years in the classroom and facilitating professional development opportunities where new and veteran teachers learn alongside one another jennifer believes and her book demonstrates that when schools embrace encourage and celebrate the work of new teachers they establish a supportive environment that fosters excellence and improves retention

despite significant reforms in the past decade in relation to criteria and standards based assessment in tertiary education contexts assessment remains the most significantly criticised aspect of the student tertiary experience and a major driver of student engagement the key tool in this experience is the rubric also known as the criteria sheet or the guide to making judgments this book discusses the significance of assessment rubrics in tertiary education assessment rubrics impact the student experience in multiple ways as a guide to students and assessors prior to grading at the point of grading by the assessor when moderating during the post grading process in providing an additional guide to students in the assessment planning stage and as a feedback mechanism to

students once results are released this book explains how the rubric reflects key principles of assessment it explores different models of rubrics used in tertiary contexts and provides data from students and academics on the efficacy of these various models as the key tool when marking moderating and providing feedback it also details exemplars of rubrics used in academic disciplines and discusses how higher education teachers use exemplars and how they integrate exemplars with criteria and rubrics it captures the student voice by explaining how students use rubrics for self assessment and self regulation purposes a key inclusion is the importance of sessional staff input into the creation of assessment rubrics prior to the grading moderating and feedback processes

as of spring 2015 in the states of new york tennessee washington and wisconsin all pre service teacher candidates are required to pass the education teaching performance assessment to earn initial teaching certification california georgia ohio and massachusetts are planning to adopt the edtpa while eighteen other states are considering adopting this policy in the near future re engaging students for success planning for the education teaching performance assessment is designed to assist elementary candidates with an educational methodology to pass the education teaching performance assessment the methodology can be used to plan implement and assess student learning during instruction additionally this method will assist elementary teacher candidates in using the common core standards to design lessons to assess student learning while managing classroom instruction candidates who have used this method have successfully beat the tests

in antiracist writing assessment ecologies asao b inoue theorizes classroom writing assessment as a complex system that is more than its interconnected elements to explain how and why antiracist work in the writing classroom is vital to literacy learning inoue incorporates ideas about the white racial habitus that informs dominant discourses in the academy and other contexts

what is assessed gets attention what is not assessed does not when higher education is expected to promote complex achievements in subject disciplines and in terms of employability problems arise how are such achievements to be assessed in the first part of the book it is argued that existing grading practices cannot cope with the expectations laid upon them while the potential of formative assessment for the support of learning is not fully realised the authors argue that improving the effectiveness of assessment depends on a well grounded appreciation of what assessment is and what may and may not be expected of it the second part covers summative judgements for high stakes purposes using established measurement theory a view is developed of the conditions under which affordable useful valid and reliable summative judgements can be made one conclusion is that many complex achievements

recent performance based teacher assessments have challenged teacher educators to rethink the ways that candidates are prepared in education programs edtpa formerly the teacher performance assessment requires teacher candidates to demonstrate knowledge and skills through authentic teaching artifacts written commentary and video clips recorded in real classroom settings as part of the edtpa requirements teacher candidates submit video clips of their own teaching to be viewed and assessed by evaluators this implies that teacher candidates should know how to utilize their own videos for the purpose of improving their instructional skills as well as

the learning of their students these initiatives have urged teacher educators to prepare their candidates for the active use of video recorded instruction either in university classrooms or in field based practices this book provides research based strategies to support video analysis of authentic teaching in initial teacher education programs it also presents a review of video recording tools in reference to their features and practicality for different educational settings

effectiveness and those who believe that valid assessment of student achievement is based on assessing the work that students produce along and at the end of their educational journeys this book espouses the latter philosophy what peggy maki sees as an integrated and authentic approach to providing evidence of student learning based on the work that students produce along the chronology of their learning she believes that assessment needs to be humanized as opposed to standardized to take into account the demographics of institutions as students do not all start at the same place in their learning students also need the tools to assess their own progress in addition to updating and expanding the contents of her first edition to reflect changes in assessment practices and developments over the last seven years such as the development of technology enabled assessment methods and the national need for institutions to demonstrate that they are using results to improve student learning maki focuses on ways to deepen program and institution level assessment within the context of collective inquiry about student learning recognizing that assessment is not initially a linear start up process or even necessarily sequential and recognizing that institutions develop processes appropriate for their mission and culture this book does not take a prescriptive or formulaic approach to building this commitment what it does present is a framework with examples of processes and strategies to assist faculty staff administrators and campus leaders to develop a sustainable and shared core institutional process that deepens inquiry into what and how students learn to identify and improve patterns of weakness that inhibit learning this book is designed to assist colleges and universities build a sustainable commitment to assessing student learning at both the institution and program levels it provides the tools for collective inquiry among faculty staff administrators and students to develop evidence of students abilities to integrate apply and transfer learning as well as to construct their own meaning each chapter also concludes with 1 an additional resources section that includes references to meta sites with further resources so users can pursue particular issues in greater depth and detail and 2 worksheets guides and exercises designed to build collaborative ownership of assessment the second edition now covers strategies to connect students to an institution s or a program s assessment commitment description of the components of a comprehensive institutional commitment that engages the institution educators and students all as learners expanded coverage of direct and indirect assessment methods including technology enabled methods that engage students in the process new case studies and campus examples covering undergraduate graduate education and the co curriculum new chapter with case studies that presents a framework for a backward
