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an anthology of 247 memorable poems by six of america's greatest poets encompasses the works of walt whitman emily dickinson william carlos williams wallace stevens robert frost and langston hughes

in this generous anthology joel conarroe has assembled the work of eight poets who have shaped and to some extent defined american verse since 1940 elizabeth bishop james merrill sylvia plath allen ginsberg theodore roethke john berryman anne sexton and robert lowell the 164 selections in eight american poets include widely anthologized works like roethke's my papa's waltz several of berryman's dream songs and anne sexton's ringing the bells as well as poems that are less familiar but just as haunting prefaced with a discerning introduction and individual biographical essays

this companion brings together essays on some fifty four american poets from anne bradstreet to contemporary performance poetry this book also examines such movements in american poetry as modernism the harlem or new negro renaissance confessional poetry the black mountain school the new york school the beats and language poetry

the ethnically diverse scope broad chronological coverage and mix of biographical critical historical political and cultural entries make this the most useful and exciting poetry reference of its kind for students today american poetry springs up out of all walks of life its poems are maternal as well as paternal stuff d with the stuff that is coarse and stuff d with the stuff that is fine as walt whitman wrote adding of every hue and caste am i of every rank and religion written for high school and undergraduate students this two volume encyclopedia covers u s poetry from the colonial era to the present offering full treatments of hundreds of key poets of the american canon what sets this reference apart is that it also discusses events movements schools and poetic approaches placing poets in their social historical political cultural and critical contexts and showing how their works mirror the eras in which they were written readers will learn about surrealism ekphrastic poetry pastoral elegy the black mountain poets and language poetry there are long and rich entries on modernism and postmodernism as well as entries related to the formal and technical dimensions of american poetry particular attention is paid to women poets and poets from various ethnic groups poets such as amiri baraka nathaniel mackey natasha trethewey and tracy smith are featured the encyclopedia also contains entries on a wide selection of latino and native american poets and substantial coverage of the avant garde and experimental movements and provides sidebars that illuminate key points

donald allen s prophetic anthology had an electrifying effect on two generations at least of american poets and readers more than the repetition of familiar names and ideas that most anthologies seem to be about here was the declaration of a collective intelligent and thoroughly visionary work in progress the primary example for its time of the anthology as manifesto its republication today complete with poems statements on poetics and autobiographical projections provides us again with a model of how a contemporary anthology can and should be shaped in these essentials it remains as fresh and useful a guide as it was in 1960 jerome rothenberg editor of poems for the millennium the new american poetry is a crucial cultural document central to defining the poetics and the broader cultural dynamics of a particular historical moment alan golding author of from outlaw to classic canons in american poetry

america did not declare independence in its poetry as quickly or as dramatically as in politics it took time for the new nation to free itself from the many and widely contrasting traditions customs codes and cultures it had inherited and expressed

itself through scores of imitators before it found its own characteristic way of thinking reacting and writing here is the poetry of early america revealing the spirit the scenes and the turbulence of the period and setting forth the works of over forty accomplished poets many of whom are forgotten to all but the literary historian this collection is devoted to the expanding spirit as well as the formative genius of america

no poetry is more fresh more immediate more deftly challenging writes editor robert pinsky william carlos williams is at the center of one of poetry's greatest historical flowerings a poet of astonishing range and inventiveness williams was at once a daring formal innovator one of the band of modernists who transformed american poetry and an intimate sometimes savagely frank chronicler of the life and landscape of his native new jersey from the beginning he pursued an independent course creating a diverse and unfailingly vital body of work from the hard edged experiments of spring and all to the fluent lyricism of asphodel that greeny flower his influence on generations of poets has been indelible and as this masterful new selection demonstrates his poems retain their capacity to astonish and delight about the american poets project elegantly designed in compact editions printed on acid free paper and textually authoritative the american poets project makes available the full range of the american poetic accomplishment selected and introduced by today's most discerning poets and critics

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even though asian american literature is enjoying an impressive critical popularity attention has focused primarily on longer narrative forms such as the novel and despite the proliferation of a large number of poets of asian descent in the 20th century asian american poetry remains a neglected area of study poetry as an elite genre has not reached the level of popularity of the novel or short story partly due to the difficulties of reading and interpreting poetic texts the lack of criticism on asian american poetry speaks to the urgent need for scholarship in this area since perhaps more than any other genre poetry most forcefully captures the intense feelings and emotions that asian americans have experienced about themselves and their world this reference book overviews the tremendous cultural contributions of asian american poets included are alphabetically arranged entries on 48 american poets of asian descent most of whom have been active during the latter half of the 20th century each entry begins with a short biography which sometimes includes information drawn from personal interviews the entries then discuss the poet s major works and themes including such concerns as family racism sexism identity language and politics a survey of the poet s critical reception follows in many cases the existing criticism is scant and the entries offer new readings of neglected works the entries conclude with bibliographies of primary and secondary texts and the volume closes with a selected general bibliography

intense resonant and deeply literary this account of an american poetics shows how today s consumerist and conformist culture subverts the imagination of a free people poetry the author maintains is central to any coherent vision of life

african american asian american latinx and indigenous poetries both a nuanced survey of american poetry and a catalyst for future scholarship a companion to american poetry is essential reading for advanced undergraduate and graduate students academic researchers and scholars and general readers with interest in current trends in american poetry

this companion provides a chronological survey of latin american poetry analysis of modern trends and six succinct essays on the major figures

the american poet laureate shows how the state has been the silent center of poetic production in the united states since world war ii it is the first history of the national poetry office the u s poet laureate highlighting the careers of elizabeth bishop robert frost gwendolyn brooks robert pinsky tracy k smith juan felipe herrera and joy harjo at the nation s capitol it is also a history of how these state poets participated in national arts programming during the cold war drawing on previously unexplored archival materials at the library of congress and materials at the john f kennedy presidential library amy paeth describes the interactions of federal bodies including the central intelligence agency the state department and the national endowment for the arts with literary organizations and with private patrons including prozac heiress ruth lilly the consolidation of public and private interests is crucial to the development of state verse culture recognizable at the first national poetry festival in 1962 which followed robert frost s mission to moscow and which became dominant in the late 1990s and early 2000s the american poet laureate contributes to a growing body of institutional and sociological approaches to u s literary production in the postwar era and demonstrates how poetry has played a uniquely important and largely underacknowledged role in the cultural front of the cold war

offers a critical history of african american poetry from the transatlantic slave trade to present day hip hop

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
