we hold many assumptions about police work—that it is the responsibility

of the state or that police officers are given the right to kill in the name of public safety or self defense but in the killing consensus graham denyer willis shows how in s o paulo brazil killing and the arbitration of "normal" killing in the name of social order are actually conducted by two groups—the police and organized crime—both operating according to parallel logics of murder based on three years of ethnographic fieldwork willis s book traces how homicide detectives categorize two types of killing the first resulting from "resistance" to police arrest which is often broadly defined and the second at the hands of a crime family known as the primeiro comando da capital pcc death at the hands of police happens regularly while the pcc's centralized control and strict moral code among criminals has also routinized killing ironically making the city feel safer for most residents in a fractured urban security environment where killing mirrors patterns of inequitable urbanization and historical exclusion along class gender and racial lines denyer willis s research finds that the city's cyclical periods of peace and violence can best be understood through an unspoken but mutually observed consensus on the right to kill this consensus hinges on common notions and street level practices of who can die where how and by whom revealing an empirically distinct configuration of authority that denyer willis calls sovereignty by consensus

with a brilliantly plotted new crime novel set in small town massachusetts chuck hogan prizewinning author of prince of thieves delivers a page turning knockout thriller that demonstrates why he is the unrivaled master of gritty suspense the crack of a handgun shatters the silence of a warm summer night a notorious local felon and former child magician vanishes seemingly without a trace a corrupt police force applies a stranglehold to a failing town an ailing old man hatches a last ditch plan to save the police department he once headed and the community he still loves an outsider arrives bearing a simple recipe for death that could destroy them all buried deep in the rural backcountry of new england the town of black falls isn t dying so much as quietly fading away no supermarket no traffic lights no atm no hope donald maddox a man with no law enforcement background indeed no background at all has returned to his hometown after fifteen years to find himself employed as an auxiliary patrolman on a local police force known to inspire more fear than trust in its citizenry when a brutal murder shatters the isolation of this forgotten place triggering the arrival of state police homicide detectives and a town wide manhunt both the local

cops and maddox appear to have something to hide as the tightly wound mystery that is maddox's past begins to unravel he becomes ensnared in a deadly conspiracy that ultimately threatens his life as well as the lives of those nearest him from its opening pages until its haunting final image the killing moon displays the author's trademark gift for soul deep characterization crisp pacing and unflinching realism this is chuck hogan's richest most satisfying thriller yet

in this groundbreaking work of investigative journalism and true crime stacy horn sheds light on how the subprime mortgage scandal of the 1970s and a long history of white collar crime slowly devastated east new york a brooklyn neighborhood that would come to be known as the killing fields on a warm summer evening in 1991 seventeen year old julia parker was murdered in the brooklyn neighborhood of east new york an area known for an exorbitant level of violence and crime east new york had come to be known as the killing fields in the six months after julia parker's death 62 more people were murdered in the same area in the early 1990s murder rates in the neighborhood climbed to the highest in nypd history east new york was dying but how did this once thriving diverse family neighborhood fall into such ruin the answer can be found two decades earlier in response to redlining and discriminatory housing practices the johnson administration passed the housing and urban development act in 1968 the federal housing authority aimed to use this piece of legislation to help low income families of color finally achieve homeownership but they could never have predicted how banks lenders realtors and corrupt fha officials themselves would use the newly passed law to make victims of the very people they were supposed to help and the devastation they would leave in their wake a compulsively readable hybrid of true crime and investigative journalism the killing fields of east new york reveals how white collar crime reduced a prospering neighborhood to abandoned buildings and empty lots following the dual threads of the hunt for the network of criminals behind the first subprime mortgage scandal and the ensuing downfall of east new york stacy horn weaves a compelling narrative of government failure a desperate community and ultimately the largest series of mortgage fraud prosecutions in american history the killing fields of east new york deftly demonstrates how different types of crime are profoundly entangled and how the crimes committed in nice suits and corner offices are just as destructive as those committed on the street

over the course of 66 days in 1967 more than 4 000 class enemies

including young children and the elderly were murdered in daoxian a county in china's hunan province the killings spread to surrounding counties resulting in a combined death toll of more than 9 000 commonly known as the daoxian massacre the killings were one of many acts of so called mass dictatorship and armed factional conflict that rocked china during the cultural revolution however in spite of the scope and brutality of the killings there are few detailed accounts of mass killings in china's countryside during the cultural revolution's most tumultuous years years after the massacre journalist tan hecheng was sent to daoxian to report on an official investigation into the killings tan was prevented from publishing his findings in china but in 2010 he published the chinese edition of the killing wind in hong kong tan's first hand investigation of the atrocities accumulated over the course of more than 20 years blends his research with the recollections of survivors to provide a vivid account exploring how and why the massacre took place and describing its aftermath dispelling the heroic aura of class struggle tan reveals that most of the daoxian massacre's victims were hard working peaceful members of the rural middle class blacklisted as landlords or rich peasants tan also describes how political pressure and brainwashing turned ordinary people into heartless killing machines more than a catalog of horrors the killing wind is also a poignant meditation on memory moral culpability and the failure of the chinese government to come to terms with the crimes of the maoist era by painting a detailed portrait of this massacre tan makes a broader argument about the long term consequences of the cultural revolution one of the most violent political movements of the twentieth century a compelling testament to the victims and survivors of the daoxian massacre the killing wind is a monument to historical truth one that fills an immense gap in our understanding of the mao era the cultural revolution and the status of truth in contemporary china

on january 21 2015 a pro isis twitter account reported that john maguire a 23 year old university drop out from the ottawa valley town of kemptville had been killed fighting kurds in the syrian city of kobani a few weeks before maguire had starred in a youtube video threatening canada for bombing isis forces in iraq he is one of the dozens of young canadians who have chosen to fight in a vicious conflict that really had little to do with them and with canada why would young people choose to fight in other people's wars especially one as bloody and cruel as this one why has isis become so good at attracting foreign fighters this book

examines the lure of this radical islamist movement its religious beliefs sophisticated propaganda and vast social media networks isis is now a go to cause for alienated young people in the islamic world and the west does it offer answers to troubled young people are isis s crimes slavery murder rape repression and the destruction of heritage sites an attraction in and of themselves what do we do about the people who take up isis s cause but stay in their home country what do we do with the isis recruits who come home the killing game examines what draws young men and women to join violent social political movements it looks at the psychology of young men and women today and the propaganda used by all sides in the middle east conflicts as well as the security laws and the political initiatives that have been designed to stop Canadians from being radicalized from the irresistible lure of marxist leninism of the 1930s through the 60s and 70s and including the appeal of nazism to young Germans in the 1930s this book also investigates what it is that draws young people to join and fight for causes as different as the spanish civil war of the 1930s and the red brigades of the 1970s but with an emphasis on the attraction of isis and radical islam in our own time

a compelling read highly recommended for its extraordinarily powerful insight into the frayed edges of the first months of the european war the western front association why did the Germans brutally and illegally execute a group of British soldiers who had been trapped behind the lines during the retreat to the Marne in 1914 Hedley Malloch in this gripping and meticulously researched account vividly describes the fate the soldiers on the run and of the French civilians who sheltered them he tells a dramatic and tragic story of escape betrayals and punishment that also gives a fascinating insight into the life stories of the soldiers and civilians involved and the mind set of the German army on the western front the book names the German officers responsible for this atrocity and explores their motivations this is an episode of WW1 with which i am not familiar and one that i found particularly fascinating and at the same time harrowing the author attempts to set the record straight by naming the perpetrators of this enormous outrage books monthly Hedley Malloch who is chair of the Iron Memorial Fund and honorary life member of the RMFA has done a wonderful job with his book a true memorial in its own right to those that were executed innocent soldiers who just happened to find themselves on the wrong side of the lines redcoat and khaki if you have a top ten books on the first world

war then make room for the killing of the iron twelve by hedley malloch the western front association

stop the killing offers insight into what each of us can do to end the active shooter crisis plaguing america written by the former head of the fbi s active shooter program katherine schweit shares an insider look at what we ve learned and failed to learn about protecting our businesses houses of worship and schools the book demystifies the language around active shooters mass killings threat assessment teams and more never gathered before into one place readers gain access to evidence based research and the most up to date information as they travel step by step through shooting prevention efforts and shooting aftermaths beginning with an understanding of how to spot potential shooters readers learn the many ways to prevent shootings and the role threat assessment teams play threat assessment experts provide insight on what kind of information they need and how they use it to intercept a person on a pathway to violence the book guides readers through the process of assessing building security weaknesses and shows how to find vulnerabilities in people programs and policies packed with practical advice for training every age from preschoolers to elementary school children to adults the book also includes the author s own teaching outline on how to train people to run hide fight the book gathers together examples to help build individualized emergency operations plans and shows how to tap vast government resources to cover costs to your office and employees districts and students and survivors and victim s families hear sober advice gathered from those who have survived and responded to shootings at columbine high school virginia tech sandy hook elementary school the aurora theater los angeles international airport and more their common theme is that it can happen anywhere and has all the more reason to accept that as each of us better understand what happens and how to prevent it we can be the ones to stop the killing the book also features a new preface exploring the 2021 school shooting tragedy in michigan especially the groundbreaking use of a domestic terrorism charge filed against the shooter and involuntary manslaughter charges filed against his parents

targeted killing of terrorists has become an established practice in the fight against terrorism the disturbing consequences of the practice and its increasing political and societal acceptance raise questions as to its justifiability and its place in counter terrorism anna goppel explores whether targeted killing of terrorists can be justified both

from a moral and an international legal perspective she discusses moral and international legal limits to state use of lethal force and argues that the moral principles and the international legal regulations allow for the practice only in very specific very rare and rather hypothetical cases the analysis is based on a thorough discussion of the human right to life the laws and ethics of war and the relevant moral and legal arguments this makes it of particular interest to philosophers and legal theorists interested in terrorism counter terrorism human rights and the legitimacy of defensive state measures

explores the rough and tumble world of frontier justice texas style

aleksandar borko a 38 year old serbian immigrant and 36 year old lucas frayne an american born citizen right from an early age borko and frayne had unusual and sadistic appetites for all manner of twisted and vile acts of torture and murder for years the death toll of their victims escalated between 2008 to 2018 will the fbi and law enforcement agencies capture them

a tv actress is murdered and it would seem that the alleged perpetrator has been framed as the investigation progresses the reader is not fooled into taking an incorrect conclusion but that is not to say the ending is perhaps one of the most ingenious and surprising to be found in this genre full of detail and strong rounded characters

the book explores the main moral ethical and operational dilemmas of targeted killings from an israeli perspective even though many countries contending with terrorism have adopted this tool either overtly or covertly within the arsenal used in implementing their counter terrorism policies it seems that israel as one of the world s leading practitioner of targeted killing in its counter terrorism effort constitutes the most appropriate case study for reviewing implications and dilemmas associated with this practice each chapter will present a different ethical moral operational dilemma emanating from a deployment of a targeted killing the analysis of israeli considerations and solutions to these dilemmas is built around interviews with israeli decision makers former senior security officials and other experts the chapters also cover public opinion polls in order to highlight the views of the israeli public vis a vis each dilemma finally chapters will conclude with lessons learned and offer recommendations for a practical and moral solution the final chapter then draws together universal conclusions and

recommendations for the use of targeted killings

according to the dominant account of rights there are two ways to permissibly kill people they have done something to forfeit their right to life or their rights are outweighed by the significantly greater cost of respecting them contemporary just war theorists tend to agree that it is difficult to justify killing in the second way thus they focus on the conditions under which rights might be forfeited but it has proven hard to defend an account of forfeiture that permits killing when and only when it is morally justifiable in the mechanics of claims and permissible killing in war alec d walen develops an alternative account of rights according to which rights forfeiture has a much smaller role to play it plays a smaller role because rights themselves are more contextually contingent they systematically reflect the different kinds of claims people can make on an agent for example those who threaten to cause harm without a right to do so have weaker claims not to be killed than innocent bystanders or those who have a right to threaten to cause harm by framing rights as the output of a balance of competing claims and by laying out a detailed account of how to balance competing claims walen provides a more coherent account of when killing in war is permissible

the war on terror is remaking conventional warfare the protracted battle against a non state organization the demise of the confinement of hostilities to an identifiable battlefield the extensive involvement of civilian combatants and the development of new and more precise military technologies have all conspired to require a rethinking of the law and morality of war just war theory as traditionally articulated seems ill suited to justify many of the practices of the war on terror the raid against osama bin laden s pakistani compound was the highest profile example of this strategy but the issues raised by this technique cast a far broader net every week the u s military and cia launch remotely piloted drones to track suspected terrorists in hopes of launching a missile strike against them in addition to the public condemnation that these attacks have generated in some countries the legal and moral basis for the use of this technique is problematic is the u s government correct that nations attacked by terrorists have the right to respond in self defense by targeting specific terrorists for summary killing is there a limit to who can legitimately be placed on the list there is also widespread disagreement about whether suspected terrorists should be considered combatants subject to the risk of lawful killing under the

laws of war or civilians protected by international humanitarian law complicating the moral and legal calculus is the fact that innocent bystanders are often killed or injured in these attacks this book addresses these issues featuring chapters by an unrivalled set of experts it discusses all aspects of targeted killing making it unmissable reading for anyone interested in the implications of this practice

the handbook on the economics of conflict conveys how economics can contribute to the understanding of conflict in its various dimensions embracing world wars regional conflicts terrorism and the role of peacekeeping in conflict prevention the economics of conflict is a relatively new branch of the discipline of economics conflict provides opportunities for applying game theory involving strategic behaviour interactions and interdependence between adversaries the handbook demonstrates that conflict and its prevention is costly it considers new dimensions such as ethnic cleansing destructive power terrorism corruption the impact of new technology peacekeeping the role of economists in defence ministries and the use of private contractors in conflict

the felony murder doctrine is one of the most widely criticized features of american criminal law legal scholars almost unanimously condemn it as irrational concluding that it imposes punishment without fault and presumes guilt without proof despite this the law persists in almost every u s jurisdiction felony murder is the first book on this controversial legal doctrine it shows that felony murder liability rests on a simple and powerful idea that the guilt incurred in attacking or endangering others depends on one s reasons for doing so inflicting harm is wrong and doing so for a bad motive such as robbery rape or arson aggravates that wrong in presenting this idea guyora binder criticizes prevailing academic theories of criminal intent for trying to purge criminal law of moral judgment ultimately binder shows that felony murder law has been and should remain limited by its justifying aims

the commentaries were long regarded as the leading work on the development of english law and played a role in the development of the american legal system they were in fact the first methodical treatise on the common law suitable for a lay readership since at least the middle ages this is book four out of four including more than 1700 footnotes and annotations

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
