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henry cowell a man made of music is the first complete biography of one of the most innovative figures in twentieth century

american music it explores in detail the complexities and impact of his life work and teachings

morkinskinna rotten parchment the first full length chronicle of the kings of medieval norway 1030 1157 forms the basis of the icelandic chronicle tradition based ultimately on an original from ca 1220 the single defective manuscript was written in iceland ca 1275 the present volume the first translation of morkinskinna in any language makes this literary milestone available to a general readership with introduction and commentary to clarify its position in the history of medieval icelandic letters the book is designed to be used by readers with no knowledge of icelandic the translation is keyed to and may be used in conjunction with the existing diplomatic editions notes on the manuscript problems as well as introductory and appended matter augment the text above all kari ellen gade s edition of the skaldic stanzas provides a substantial initial step toward a future edition of the icelandic text morkinskinna is the first large scale repository of skaldic verse morkinskinna also includes many semi independent tales that recount the adventures of individual icelanders at the norwegian court these tales with their often humorous or ironic inflections shift the focus of the chronicle from the deeds of the kings to the icelandic perception of norwegian royalty

william ian miller presents a close reading of one of the best known of the icelandic sagas showing its moral political and psychological sophistication his account of this complex and nuanced saga corrects simplistic readings which have governed interpretation of the saga in the past

georgia the last of britain s american mainland colonies began with high aspirations to create a morally sound society based on small family farms with no enslaved workers but those goals were not realized and georgia became a slave plantation society following the carolina model this trajectory of failure is well known but looking at the salzburgers who emigrated from europe as part of the original plan provides a very different story the good forest reveals the experiences of the salzburger migrants who came to georgia with the support of british and german philanthropy where they achieved self sufficiency in the ebenezer settlement while following the trustees plans because their settlement comprised a significant portion of georgia s early population their experiences provide a corrective to our understanding of early georgia and help reveal the possibilities in atlantic colonization as they built a cohesive community the relative success of the ebenezer settlement furthermore challenges the inherent environmental cultural and economic determinism that has dominated georgia history that well worn narrative often implies or even explicitly states that only a slave based plantation economy as implemented after the trustee era could succeed with this history auman illuminates the interwoven themes of atlantic migrations colonization charity and transatlantic religious networks

this volume centres upon the era conventionally labelled the making of the kingdom or the anglo norman era in scottish history it seeks a balance between traditional historiographical concentration on the feudalisation of scottish society as part of the wholesale importation of alien cultural traditions by a modernising monarchy and more recent emphasis on the continuing vitality and centrality of gaelic culture and traditions within the twelfth and early thirteenth century kingdom part i explores the transition from the gaelic kingship of alba into the hybridised medieval state and traces scotland s role as both dominated and dominator it examines the redefinition of relationships with england gaelic magnates within scotland s traditional territorial heartland and with autonomous independent mainland and insular powers these interrelationships form the central theme of an exploration of the struggle for political domination of the northern mainland of britain and the adjacent islands the mechanisms through which that domination was projected and expressed and the manner of its expression part ii is a thematic exploration of central aspects of the society and culture of late eleventh to early thirteenth century scotland which gave character and substance to the emerging kingdom it considers the evolutionary growth of scottish economic structures changes in the management of land based resources and the manner in which secular power and authority were acquired and exercised these themes are developed in discussions of the emergence of urban communities and in the

creation of a new noble class in the twelfth century religion is examined both in terms of the development of the church as an institution and through the religious experience of the lay population

this book examines translations of icelandic sagas and the victorian and edwardian children s literature they inspired some of which are canonical while others are forgotten it covers authors like william morris henry wadsworth longfellow thomas gray walter scott h rider haggard w h auden john greenleef whittier and more in lavish volumes and modest schoolbooks british and american writers claimed nordic heritage and explored nordic traditions the sagas offered a rich and wide ranging source for these authors volsunga saga s sigurd the dragon slayer king olaf s saga of opposing nordic gods and christianity frithiof s model of headstrong youth beset with unfair opposition and lost love grettir and njal tell of men who accepted fate and met conflict and enemies unflinchingly aslaug gudrida hallberga and hervar exerted remarkable influence and eric the red and leif the lucky provided americans with a nordic heritage of discovery

the focus of this book is medieval vernacular literature in western europe chapters are written by experts in the area and present the current scholarship at the time this book was originally published in 1996 each chapter has a bibliography of important works in that area as well this is a thorough and reliable guide to trends in research on medieval arthuriana

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
