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in may 1967 during a discussion about his yet to be released film eat the document bob dylan cryptically remarked the film is finished it s different it would not be the last time he could make this claim beyond his musical prowess dylan s career encompasses a lesser explored facet that of a filmmaker creating works that defy convention this book delves into these cinematic forays unravelling the intriguing interplay of dylan s presence both behind and in front of the camera dylan s cinematic

experiments ranging from the ground breaking *Dont Look Back* 1967 to the enigmatic masked and anonymous 2003 stand as unique and thought provoking additions to his artistic legacy unveiling an experimental and inquisitive sensibility these films draw inspiration not only from cinematic predecessors but also from dylan s songcraft often residing in the periphery of dylan studies a closer examination of his cinematic oeuvre reveals an underrated auteur who fearlessly transcends the boundaries of the page stage and screen

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bob dylan's iconic 1962 song a hard rain's a gonna fall stands at the crossroads of musical and literary traditions a visionary warning of impending apocalypse it sets symbolist imagery within a structure that recalls a centuries-old form written at the height of the 1960s folk music revival amid the ferment of political activism the song strongly resembles and at the same time reimagines a traditional european ballad sung from scotland to italy known in the english speaking world as lord randal alessandro portelli explores the power and resonance of a hard rain's a gonna fall considering the meanings of history and memory in folk cultures and in dylan's work

he examines how the ballad tradition to which lord randal belongs shaped dylan s song and how dylan drew on oral culture to depict the fears and crises of his own era portelli recasts the song as an encounter between dylan s despairing vision which questions the meaning and direction of history and the message of resilience and hope for survival despite history s nightmares found in oral traditions a wide ranging work of oral history hard rain weaves together interviews from places as varied as italy england and india with portelli s autobiographical reflections and critical analysis speaking to the enduring appeal of dylan s music by exploring the motley traditions that shaped dylan s work this book casts the distinctiveness and depth of his songwriting in a new light

taking readers behind bob dylan s familiar image as the enigmatic rebel of the 1960s this book reveals a different view that of a careful craftsman and student of the art of songwriting drawing on revelations from dylan s memoir chronicles and a variety of other sources the author arrives at a radically new interpretation of his body of work which revolutionized american music and won him the nobel prize for literature in 2016 dylan s songs are viewed as collages ingeniously combining themes and images from american popular culture and european high culture

this book argues that the songs on bob dylan s john wesley harding are deeply concerned with the fractures in collective memory and politics contemporary with its composition and recording the songs are thorough investigations of the ethics of memory in america critics and curators frame this song series as a return to dylan s folk roots and as a retreat from the political specifically critics argue that dylan on this album retreats from the explicitly political into the realm of timeless universal moral concerns as if these discourses can be so separated the present book seeks to remedy these oversights and illuminate the reception of dylan s songwriting art the summer of 1967 was understood by white middle class young people as the summer of love for african americans 1967 was understood as the long hot summer of racial tension and rioting dylan s aversion to the summer of love is well documented and john wesley harding is understood by critics as yet another step by dylan away from his audience s desires this book examines what the album s provocation entails it asserts that the album is a reckoning with the tensions in american memory and history that subtend the explosive long hot summer the book deploys a method informed by poststructuralism especially the work of jacques derrida to a dismantle the notion of original and authentic forms and histories to which one can return and b explain how this ironic dismantling expresses a deeply felt ethical response to american memory and its discontents in so doing the book asks how art can respond to our chaotic and strife ridden century

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
