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hyde coming to mean a person who is vastly different in moral character from one situation to the next this book is one of the most gripping and fascinating books i have ever read it is such a riveting thriller that it is impossible to stop reading it even though it is a bit spooky the story begins with the will of dr henry jekyll where we learn that if he disappears or dies his fortune will be left to mr edward hyde through the lawyer mr utterson we come to know jekyll and hyde mr utterson says hyde is a cruel and vicious man who knocks over a child on purpose and steps on her without a care but this is only the beginning of his evil behaviour later on he kills an mp without reason hyde is seen going into dr jekyll s home several times on different nights how are the two men connected dr jekyll is a kind and responsible man but he is worried it seems dr jekyll is protecting mr hyde but why as we follow mr utterson and through the clever use of letters written by jekyll and hyde we discover the terrible secret that connects them this is a very well written book with descriptive and powerful language the characters and their feelings are described beautifully for example mr utterson spent his words as rarely as gold and hyde who stares at people with a sneering coolness like the devil himself making people feel uncomfortable just by looking at him there are two main ideas in the story firstly the battle of good versus evil we see this in the story of dr jekyll and mr hyde and how he struggles to keep balance between both sides of himself secondly it is about taking science too far and if we can control scientific research

the story of a london doctor who invents a secret formula which turns him into an evil and ugly person who stalks the streets at night killing people
