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abalone arizona is a sleepy southwestern town whose chief concerns are boredom and surviving the great depression that is until the circus of dr lao arrives and immensely and irrevocably changes the lives of everyone drawn to its tents expecting a sideshow spectacle the citizens of abalone instead confront and learn profound lessons from the mythical made real a chimera a medusa a talking sphinx a sea serpent witches the hound of the hedges a werewolf a mermaid an ancient god and the elusive ever changing dr lao the circus unfolds spinning magical dark strands that ensnare the town s populace the sea serpent s tale shatters love s illusions the fortune teller s shocking pronouncements toll the tedium and secret dread of every person s life sensual undercurrents pour forth for men and women alike and the dead walk again dazzling and macabre literary and philosophical the circus of dr lao has been acclaimed as a masterpiece of speculative fiction and influenced such writers as ray bradbury this bison frontiers of imagination edition features a new introduction by noted fantasy writer john marco and striking illustrations by boris artzybasheff from the first edition

the gothic and the carnivalesque in american culture offers an overview and critique of the development of gothic studies as a field this provides a short history of the field introduces the idea that the way we read gothic texts is often different to how we might read literature this offers a new way of understanding texts that are not wholly serious in their representations and is widely applicable to a number of genre productions provides analysis of popular and cult authors shows and publications

that are underdescribed in most discussions of the american gothic including h p lovecraft and weird tales ray bradbury ec comics creepy eerie and vampirella magazines tv shows such as thriller and night gallery stephen king anne rice poppy z brite and neil gaiman s sandman

again before it could be proved that they must have come there ages before europeans ever touched the wild and beautiful california coast nearly a century would pass before an unconventional young american scientist unearths evidence of this great discovery and its mysterious disappearance taking up the challenge he begins to assemble a new generation of explorers to resume the perilous search into the ocean's depth and the shadows of history armed with cutting edge modern technology and drawing on connections to powerful families at home and abroad this time americans and chinese will follow together the path of secrets that have long proved as elusive as the ancient treasures that held them this striking debut novel by a masterful writer weaves together two fascinating eras into one remarkable tale in the shadow of the cypress is an evocative dramatic story that depicts california in all its multicultural variety with a suspense that draws the reader inexorably on until the very last page
