the future of journalism isn't what it used to be as recently as the mid 1960s few would have predicted the shocks and transformations that have swept through the news business in the last three decades the deaths of many afternoon newspapers the emergence of television as people's primary news source and the quicksilver combinations of cable television vcrs and the internet that have changed our ways of reading seeing and listening the essays in this volume seek to illuminate the future prospects of journalism mindful that grandiose predictions of the world of tomorrow tend to be the fantasies and phobias of the present written large in the 1930s and 1940s magazines such as scribner's barron's and collier's forecast that one day we would have an airplane in every garage the authors of what's next have taken a more careful view the writers start with what they know the trends that they see in journalism today and ask where will they take us in the foreseeable future for some media such as newspapers the visible horizon is decades away for others particularly anything involving the internet responsible forecasts can look ahead only for a matter of years where the likely destinations of present trends are not entirely clear the authors have tried to pose the kinds of questions that they believe people will have to address in years to come while being mindful of the tremendous influence of technology one must remember that computers punditry or market share will not ordain the future of journalism rather it will be determined by the sum of countless actions taken by journalists and other media professionals these essays with their hopes and fears cautions and enthusiasms questions and answers are an effort to create the best possible future for journalism this volume will be of interest to media professionals academics and others with an interest in the future of journalism robert giles is editor in chief of media studies journal and executive director of the media

the pulse sector is undergoing dynamic changes globally and in several regions and countries to meet the challenge of growing demand in the face of sluggish production growth realizing the importance of pulses in the human diet 2016 has been declared the international year of pulses iyp this report captures the dynamics of the pulse sector during the last three decades the examination of pulse supply demand uses trade prices and outlook would help researchers and policy makers make more informed decisions related to the sector pulse based food is an important source of dietary protein and essential minerals particularly for the vegetarian population at the global level the average share of pulses is only 5 percent of the total protein consumption but their contribution in several developing countries range between 10 and 40 percent to meet the growing demand and raise their per capita availability countries made efforts to increase production and explore trade opportunities to augment domestic supply overall between 1980 and 2013 pulses production at the global level grew at an annual rate of 1.3 percent but there were however two phases of pulses production at the global level while there was almost a period of stagnation in production of pulses during the 1990s production has sharply increased since 2005 the bulk of the increase in production came from developing countries where both area and yield growth from a low base contributed to the production for developed countries where production also grew the center of production shifted from europe to north america and oceania for developing countries two new centers of production emerged in eastern africa and southeastern asia myanmar
