health services management a case study approach offers a diverse collection of case studies to help readers learn and apply key concepts of management with an emphasis on the use of evidence in management practice the case study authors many of whom are practitioners or academics who work closely with practitioners present realistic management challenges across a variety of settings they examine potential responses to those challenges by health services managers and other stakeholders and they provide a platform for meaningful discussion of opportunities and constraints for management decision makers attempting to implement change this edition includes 60 case studies 32 of which are brand new arranged thematically into six sections the role of the manager control organizational design professional integration adaptation and accountability the new cases include the following better metrics for financial management what makes a patient centered medical home doing the right thing when the financials do not support palliative care bearing the patient voice working with patient and family advisers to improve the patient experience managed care cautionary tale a case study in risk adjustment and patient dumping learning by example is one of the oldest forms of learning and the case study approach offers a time tested way for students and healthcare professionals to develop practical skills that are not easily acquired through lectures health services management has been used in classrooms since 1978 and this eleventh edition offers a fresh take on a classic text

early modern women's writing and the future of literary history demonstrates that a full accounting of early modern women's literary and creative activities is necessary to the future of literary studies writ large despite benefiting from a rich body of scholarship and diverse critical practices early modern women's writing is still treated as an optional or secondary component of renaissance literary studies as a whole in this book dodds and dowd offer a state of the field assessment of the critical and theoretical debates that have resulted in this state of affairs in order to advance specific visions for the future dodds and dowd examine how perennial questions about authorship canon and literary value have historically influenced scholarship on early modern women's writing and its place within literary studies early modern women's writing has been perceived as belated out of sync with dominant critical trends dodds and dowd show the belatedness of early modern women's writing to be a happy accident that positions women's writing as a resource for the renewal of literary history in both the classroom and in scholarship early modern women's writing shows the way forward for the field whether in the revitalization of formalist approaches to literature through an alliance with feminism or in the integration of newer critical methodologies such as premodern critical race studies this book demonstrates that a feminist literary history that places women's writing at its center is essential to the future of english renaissance literary studies there is in other words no history of english renaissance literature without women writers

this study consists of two parts the first part offers an overview of feminism s theory of differences the second part deals with the textual analysis of poems about mothering by women from india the caribbean and africa literary criticism has dealt with the representation of mothering in prose texts the exploration of lyrical texts has not yet come since the late 1970s the acknowledgement of and the commitment to difference has been foundational for feminist theory and activism this investigation promotes a differentiated locational feminism friedman the comprehensive theoretical discussion of feminism s different concepts of gender race ethnicity and mothering builds the foundation for the main part the presentation and analysis of the poems the issue of mothering foregrounds the communicative aspect of women s experience and wants to bridge the gap between theory and practice this study however does not intend to specify mothering as a universal and unique feminine characteristic it underlines a metaphorical use and discusses the concepts of nurturing maternal practice and social parenthood regarding the extensive material this study understands itself as an explorative not concluding investigation placed at the intersections of gender studies postcolonial and classical literary studies most of all it aims at initiating a dialogue and interchange between scholars and students in the western and the third world
