fistic combat represents the greatest human drama in all of sport roman gladiators thrilled citizens and emperors alike when they entered the octagon to face an intense life threatening experience boxing the sport of kings also has its roots in the ancient civilizations of greece and rome banned in 500 a d by the emperor theodoric it resurfaced twelve centuries later in england john milton praised it as a noble art for building character in young men and sports writer a j leibling dubbed it the sweet science many of its major protagonists men such as joe louis rocky marciano and muhammad ali have become transcendent near mythic heroes but boxing is not the only combat sport and mixed martial arts in all their ferocious beauty represent the fastest growing sports genre in the world ultimate fighting championships ufc has joined boxing in paying seven figures to some of its champions and draws millions in its pay per view events this book details leading figures in boxing sumo wrestling kickboxing greco roman wrestling and mixed martial arts including organizations such as ultimate fighting pride k 1 total combat and sportfighting over 150 entries cover champions contenders and other famous combatants from all over the world as well as legendary promoters managers trainers and events also included in this encyclopedia are sidebars on controversies highlights brief bios and other

when looking for applications of ring theory in geometry one first thinks of algebraic geometry which sometimes may even be interpreted as the concrete side of commutative algebra however this highly developed branch of mathematics has been dealt with in a variety of monographs so that in spite of its technical complexity it can be regarded as relatively well accessible while in the last 120 years algebraic geometry has again and again attracted concentrated interest which right now has reached a peak once more the numerous other applications of ring theory in geometry have not been assembled in a textbook and are scattered in many papers throughout the literature which makes it hard for them to emerge from the shadow of the brilliant theory of algebraic geometry it is the aim of these proceedings to give a unifying presentation of those geometrical applications of ring theory outside of algebraic geometry and to show that they offer a considerable wealth of beautiful ideas too furthermore it becomes apparent that there are natural connections to many branches of modern mathematics e.g. to the theory of algebraic groups and of Jordan algebras and to combinatorics to make these remarks more precise we will now give a description of the contents in the first chapter an approach towards a theory of non commutative algebraic geometry is attempted from two different points of view

this volume explores the role of music as a source of inspiration and provocation for modernist writers in its consideration of modernist literature within a broad political postcolonial and internationalist context this book is an important intervention in the growing field of words and music studies it expands the existing critical debate to include lesser known writers alongside Joyce Woolf and Beckett a wide ranging

definition of modernism and the influence of contemporary music on modernist writers from the rhythm of tagore s poetry to the influence of jazz improvisation the tonality of traditional irish music to the operas of wagner these essays reframe our sense of how music inspired literary modernism exploring the points at which the art forms of music and literature collide repel and combine contributors draw on their deep musical knowledge to produce close readings of prose poetry and drama confronting the concept of what makes writing musical in doing so they uncover commonalities modernist writers pursue simultaneity and polyphony evolve the leitmotif for literary purposes and adapt the formal innovations of twentieth century music the essays explore whether it is possible for literature to achieve that unity of form and subject which music enjoys and whether literary texts can resist paraphrase can be simply themselves this book demonstrates how attention to the role of music in text in turn illuminates the manner in which we read literature
