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this is the second book in a three volume series that will cover the entire book of revelation in awe inspiring detail expounding and expanding on familiar verses in god s word that have been misunderstood and misconstrued for many years in this volume the authors explore the first half of revelation from the perspective they established so clearly in volume i that of a hebrew god speaking through a hebrew believer to an audience that was intimately familiar with the hebrew language culture customs and concepts that form both the literal and the metaphorical foundation for vast portions of revelation

this volume delineates the link between judaism and christianity between old and the new testaments and calls christians to reexamine their hebrew roots so as to effect a more authentically biblical lifestyle

jesus was an initiate and adept of the ancient judaic mysteries who strove to reinstate the tradition of the bridechamber sacrament in his time shows that jesus sought to establish equity of masculine and feminine in both spiritual practice and social traditions particularly in the sacrament of marriage reinterprets jesus key teachings in light of the ancient tradition of sacred consortship reveals what happened to the gnostic heart of christianity that jesus embodied jesus was a high initiate and master adept of the ancient judaic mysteries who strove to free people from the dead hand of the ritualists he was trained in a dissident jewish brotherhood that arose in egypt before he was born which sought to bring back the ancient judaic mysteries outlawed by the jerusalem temple at the heart of this movement was a yogic based practice known in the apocrypha as the gnosis of the heart which espoused the union of both sexes in a secret initiatic teaching as a fearless social reformer jesus wanted to restore the authority of the feminine principle including asserting the equality of man and woman in the social contract of marriage he reinstated in his own life the tradition of sacred consortship a rite known to early church fathers as the bridechamber sacrament whereby the marriage of the masculine and feminine energies was effected this rite victoria lepage suggests was the primary focus of jesus teachings the very heart of his exhortations to love thy neighbor and the source of his healing power mysteries of the bridechamber explains how as a master adept of the temple of solomon jesus derived these teachings directly from ancient judaic mystery traditions revealing both a life story for jesus that differs

markedly from the version the church has offered as well as a spiritual practice based on a mystical wisdom tradition of self initiation and transformation

we approach the bible with american eyes and therefore completely miss or misunderstand so much of it it is an old middle eastern book to really understand it we must try to understand their culture theology language and thinking a good translation is just the first step in understanding the bible figures of speech that are second nature to native speakers but often bizarre to others are especially difficult when these are further clouded by differences in customs grasping the original meaning can be very difficult what most of us fail to realize is that we do not think the same way the writers of the bible thought the logic we find so easy and familiar did not yet exist when most of the bible was written without considering those differences we try to impose on hebrew word pictures our greek logic patterns sometimes it works and at other times the results are disastrous no wonder we have loud conflict and seething separation within the church today in direct violation of jesus prayer for unity within his body this book is the result of years of answering questions from students and friends it can be understood by anyone who can read a newspaper the bible is the record of god s intervention in human affairs and where he draws a lost and hurting world to himself despite the critics shrill cries the bible can be understood

makes a persuasive argument that gothic ideas play a vital role in how hebrew writers have confronted history culture and politics robert alter author of hebrew and modernity sinister tales written since the early twentieth century by the foremost hebrew authors including s y agnon leah goldberg and amos oz reveal a darkness at the foundation of hebrew culture the ghosts of a murdered talmud scholar and his kidnapped bride rise from their graves for a nocturnal dance of death a girl hidden by a count in a secret chamber of an eastern european castle emerges to find that unbeknownst to her world war ii ended years earlier a man recounts the act of incest that would shape a trajectory of personal and national history reading these works together with central british and american gothic texts karen grumberg illustrates that modern hebrew literature has

regularly appropriated key gothic ideas to help conceptualize the jewish relationship to the past and more broadly to time she explores why these authors were drawn to the gothic originally a european mode associated with antisemitism and how they use it to challenge assumptions about power and powerlessness vulnerability and violence and to shape modern hebrew culture grumberg provides an original perspective on hebrew literary engagement with history and sheds new light on the tensions that continue to characterize contemporary israeli cultural and political rhetoric

since the calls of the second vatican council roman catholic theologians have sought to overcome an overarching problem facing jewish christian relations the concept of supersessionism the idea that god has revoked the spiritual and historical promises made to the jewish people in favour of granting those same privileges to a predominantly gentile church israel the church and millenarianism breaks new ground by applying an ancient principle to the problem of israel s replacement the early church s promotion of millennialism utilizing the best in patristic research aguzzi argues that these earliest christian traditions made room for the future of israel because christ s reign in the church was viewed as provisional to his historical reign on earth israel s role in salvation history was and is not yet complete aguzzi s research also opens the door for a greater catholic understanding of the millennial principle not shying away from its validity and relevance for understanding the importance of safeguarding jewish particularity while concluding that the synagogue and the church are indeed on a parallel trajectory what will their israel s acceptance be but life from the dead romans 11 15 ultimately the divine will is fulfilled through both christian and jewish means in history while each community is dependent in different ways upon the unfolding of god s future and the coming parousia of christ
