a full look at the harmful effect of transference the application of unresolved issues from one s past to someone in the present on churches and lives provides ways to identify and overcome this phenomenon

love your neighbor as yourself have you ever wondered what these words might mean for you in your own life elise chase has lying on a rickety canvas cot night after night while volunteering in a church sponsored emergency shelter she had a lot of time to ask herself questions about jesus s challenging command and to reflect on how new relationships with homeless men and women were changing her from the inside out fresh from an unwanted divorce elise began to realize that increasing closeness with these new neighbors was helping her both to heal from pain and loneliness and to enter a deeper relationship with jesus my neighbor my self invites readers not just into elise s own story but also into the stories of many other people it explores surprising ways that our attempts to live into the second great commandment can actually help us live more fully into the first as well discovering in the process a more fulfilling relationship with the lord

michael ward argues convincingly that medieval cosmology a subject which fascinated lewis throughout his life provides the imaginative key to the seven novels drawing on the whole range of lewis s writings including previously unpublished drafts of the chronicles ward shows that the narnia stories were designed to express the characteristics of the seven medieval planets the sun the moon mars mercury venus jupiter and saturn planets which lewis described as spiritual symbols of permanent value and especially worthwhile in our own generation using these seven symbols lewis secretly constructed the chronicles so that the story line in each book countless points of ornamental detail and most important the portrayal of the christ figure of aslan all serve to communicate the governing planetary personality

c s lewis was concerned about an aspect of the problem of evil he called subjectivism the tendency of one s perspective to move towards self referentialism and utilitarianism in c s lewis and a problem of evil jerry root provides a holistic reading of lewis by walking the reader through all of lewis s published work as he argues lewis s case against subjectivism furthermore the book reveals that lewis consistently employed fiction to make his case as virtually all of his villains are portrayed as subjectivists lewis s warnings are prophetic this book is not merely an exposition of lewis it is also a timely investigation into the problem of evil

millions of readers have been captivated by c s lewis s famed chronicles of narnia but why what is it about these seven books that makes them so appealing for more than half a century scholars have attempted to find the organizing key the secret code to the beloved series but it has remained a mystery until now in the narnia code michael ward takes the reader through each of the seven narnia books and reveals how each story embodies and expresses the characteristics of one of the seven planets of medieval cosmology jupiter mars sol luna mercury venus and saturn planets which lewis described as spiritual symbols of permanent value how does medieval cosmology relate to the christian underpinnings of the series how did it impact lewis s depiction of aslan the christlike character at the heart of the books and why did lewis keep this planetary inspiration a secret originally a ground breaking scholarly work called planet narnia this more accessible adaptation will answer all the questions

shaping the future includes a global overview of girl child issues stemming from gender discrimination and explores the root

will vaus masterfully brings together lewis s thought from throughout his voluminous writings to provide us a full orbbed look into his beliefs on twenty five christian themes

clives staples lewis 1898 1963 called his theological writings as that of a layman and an amateur who merely attempted to restate ancient and orthodox doctrines however s steve park argues that lewis s theological reflections are well informed thoughtful and weighty for instance lewis s notion of mere christianity consistently shows his commitment to supernaturalism vs naturalism and eucatastrophic salvationism vs ethical developmentalism in sharp contrast to many prevailing theologians of his time in this book the author expounded lewis s theological writings rather comprehensively and organized the results according to lewis s signature literary motif of the journey towards home in four stages away from home homeward turning home away from home and the final home under these headings lewis s major theological and literary themes find illuminating treatments with rich contents and penetrating analyses in so doing the author presents to the readers probably for the first time a systematic theology of c s lewis it turns out that lewis more than just a storyteller was a significant participant in the world of theological reflections demonstrating himself to be a rather formidable theological mind to be reckoned with

this bibliography and resource consists of a chronological introduction to the development of lewis s works a copious bibliography and a guide to the study of lewis an introductory essay on christology in lewis and a glossary for those unfamiliar with some of the background and terms to lewis s understanding of revelation and the christ it will be an invaluable resource for all scholars of c s lewis the bibliography stands alone but it also serves to complement the three volumes of the series c s lewis revelation and the christ

lewis was an amazing author who has impacted the faith of millions of people around the world unfortunately most people never read anything by c s lewis other than the chronicles of narnia this is good as far as it goes but what a shame if that s all

one ever reads of this genius although some may go on to read mere christianity or even the screwtape letters miracles or the problem of pain very few have ever mined the riches that are to be found in lewis s collected essays or had their longing for the numinous stirred by hauntingly brilliant dymer and the pilgrim s regress it is my desire in this book to show that lewis is more than just narnia beyond narnia the theology of c s lewis is an in depth analysis of the most important themes in the work of c s lewis including the sensation of joy or longing as signposts to god his view of the bible as both myth and the word of god his defense of miracles against hume s famous critique his insightful observations on the problem of pain and his often misunderstood but groundbreaking thoughts on hell this book provides an accessible and thorough introduction to c s lewis for undergraduate students and lewis fans who want to go deeper in their understanding

c s lewis embodied the christian mind because he saw the world as a coherent unity his writing consistently pursued the good the true and the beautiful he used nonfiction to point out the reasonableness of christianity and used his fiction to create compelling illustrations that make faith in christ an obvious and attractive conclusion this book explores the christian mind of c s lewis across the spectrum of the genres he worked in with contributors from diverse disciplines and interests the volume illuminates the many facets of lewis s work the christian mind of c s lewis assists readers to read lewis better and also to read other works better the overarching goal is just as lewis would have desired to help people see christ more clearly in the world and to be more like christ
