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award winning graphic novelist peter kuper presents a mesmerizing interpretation of fourteen iconic kafka short stories long fascinated with the work of franz kafka peter kuper began illustrating his stories in 1988 initially drawn to the master s dark humor kuper adapted the stories over the years to plumb their deeper truths kuper s style deliberately evokes lynd ward and frans masereel contemporaries of kafka whose wordless novels captured much of the same claustrophobia and mania as kafka s tales working from new translations of the classic texts kuper has reimagined these iconic stories for the

twenty first century using setting and perspective to comment on contemporary issues like civil rights and homelessness longtime lovers of kafka will appreciate kuper s innovative interpretations while kafka novices will discover a haunting introduction to some of the great writer s most beguiling stories including a hunger artist in the penal colony and the burrow kafkaesque stands somewhere between adaptation and wholly original creation going beyond a simple illustration of kafka s words to become a stunning work of art

winner of the 2018 silver reuben award for graphic novels a boston globe and new york public library best book of the year in kafkaesque peter kuper combines stunning artistic technique with shrewd political and social commentary for a mesmerizing interpretation of fourteen iconic franz kafka short stories

peter kuper b 1958 is one of the country s leading cartoonists his artwork has graced the pages and covers of numerous newspapers and magazines including time the new yorker mother jones and the new york times he is a longtime contributor to mad magazine where he has been writing and drawing spy vs spy for two decades and the cofounder and coeditor of world war 3 illustrated the cutting edge magazine devoted to political graphic art most of the interviews collected here are either previously unpublished or long out of print they address such varied topics as world travels teaching at harvard hollywood deal making climate change spy vs spy new york city in the 1970s and 1980s and world war 3 illustrated among the works examined are his books the system sticks and stones stop forgetting to remember diario de oaxaca and adaptations of franz kafka s the metamorphosis and upton sinclair s the jungle kuper also discusses his graphic novel ruins which received the eisner award for best new graphic novel in 2016 along with two dozen images this volume features ten lively informative interviews as well as a quartet of revealing conversations conducted in collaboration with kuper s fellow artist seth tobocman with underground comix legends robert crumb and vaughn bodé mad magazine publisher william gaines and jack kirby

illustrated by peter kuper in another ground breaking album from comicslit nine stories by franz kafka are put into bold graphic comic art by award winning illustrator and cartoonist peter kuper in an original twist kuper s take on these tales which are as true to today s world as ever refreshingly brings out the dark humour latent in kafka s work

provides a concise guide to the best graphic novels that are currently in print and available written by an enthusiast and expert in this popular field

jews created the first comic book the first graphic novel the first comic book convention the first comic book specialty store and they helped create the underground comics or comix movement of the late 60s and early 70s many of the creators of the most famous comic books such as superman spiderman x men and batman as well as the founders of mad magazine were jewish from krakow to krypton jews and comic books tells their stories and demonstrates how they brought a uniquely jewish perspective to their work and to the comics industry as a whole over sized and in full color from krakow to krypton is filled with sidebars cartoon bubbles comic book graphics original design sketches and photographs it is a visually stunning and exhilarating history

the first of two volumes builds on the brilliant and original graphic canon series in retelling classic works of literature as comics and other visual forms organized thematically volume 1 opens with the act think in cold blood and a clockwork orange followed by sections dedicated to criminals whodunit judgment scarlet letter anyone and punishment here you ll find stunning and suspenseful adaptations starring classic pis sherlock holmes auguste dupin hercule poirot father brown mike hammer and teenage girl detective violet strange but the mystery intrigue and foul play don t end or begin there the artists also bring to life crime stories from the arabian nights the bible the canterbury tales china s song dynasty shakespeare james joyce s dubliners patricia highsmith truman capote and current writers like stephen king jo nesbo and sara paretsky rick geary brings his crisp style to dostoevsky s crime and punishment teddy goldenberg gives us a dense murky treatment of dashiell hammett s the road home often considered the first hardboiled detective story ever published c frakes resurrects the forgotten novella talma gordon the first mystery written by an african american and shawn cheng renders the first serial killer story the so called fairy tale bluebeard by charles perrault even the very natures of crime justice and punishment are up for grabs landis blair reimagines the trial as a choose your own adventure story that you cannot win ted rall retells an o henry story about a petty criminal who just can t get arrested from the marquis de sade to james cain aeschylus to paula hawkins crime and mystery has never been so brilliantly reimagined

literary scholars face a new and often baffling reality in the classroom students spend

more time looking at glowing screens than reading printed text the social lives of these students take place in cyberspace instead of the student pub their favorite narratives exist in video games not books how do teachers who grew up in a different world engage these students without watering down pedagogy clint burnham and paul budra have assembled a group of specialists in visual poetry graphic novels digital humanities role playing games television studies and yes even the middle brow novel to address this question contributors give a brief description of their subject investigate how it confronts traditional notions of the literary and ask what contemporary literary theory can illuminate about their text before explaining how their subject can be taught in the 21st century classroom

as gregor samsa awoke one morning from uneasy dreams he found himself transformed in his bed into a gigantic insect so begins kafka s the metamorphosis the most subtly disturbing story in modern literature illustrations

examines the form of the novel capaciously defined and across its history exploring the interplay of conformity and experimentation in classic and outlier examples of the genre with a focus on joseph conrad henry james and virginia woolf

cuckoo's nest last exit to brooklyn j g ballard's crash and photo dioramas for animal farm and the wonderful wizard of oz feast your eyes on new full page illustrations for 1984 brave new world waiting for godot one hundred years of solitude the bell jar on the road lord of the flies the wind up bird chronicle and three borges stories robert crumb's rarely seen adaptation of nausea captures sartre's existential dread dame darcy illustrates cormac mccarthy's masterpiece blood meridian universally considered one of the most brutal novels ever written and long regarded as unfilmable by hollywood tara seibel the only female artist involved with the harvey pekar project turns in an exquisite series of illustrations for the great gatsby and then there's the moment we've been waiting for the first graphic adaptation from kurt vonnegut's masterwork slaughterhouse five among many other gems

comic books achieved almost immediate popularity and profitability when they were first introduced in the u s throughout the late 1930s and early 1940s but comic books soon suffered attacks concerning the quality of this new genre medium combining text and artwork with the rise of graphic novels in the mid 1980s and the adaptation of comics to films in the twenty first century comics and graphic novels have gained more respect as craft and text called sequential art by foundational legend will eisner but the genre medium remains marginalized by educators parents and the public challenging genres comic books and graphic novels offers educators students parents and comic book readers and collectors a comprehensive exploration of comics graphic novels as a challenging genre medium this volume presents a history of comic books graphic novels an argument for valuing the genre medium and several chapters devoted to examining all subgenres of comics graphic novels readers will discover key comics graphic novels and film adaptations suitable for the classroom and for anyone serious about high quality texts further this volume places comics graphic novels within our growing understanding of multiliteracies and critical literacy

aesthetic thematic and generic boundaries that forms the basis of some of the analyses to be found here featuring a roster of talented scholars both new and established the cinema of yorgos lanthimos films form philosophy provides a timely compendium of critical approaches to one of the most distinct voices in contemporary film

franz baermann steiner 1909 52 provided the vital link between the intellectual culture of central europe and the oxford institute of anthropology in its post second world war years this book demonstrates his quiet influence within anthropology which has extended from mary douglas to david graeber and how his remarkable poetry reflected profoundly on the slavery and murder of the shoah an event which he escaped from steiner s concerns including inter disciplinarity genre refugees and exile colonialism and violence and the sources of european anthropology speak to contemporary concerns more directly now than at any time since his early death

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
