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the essays in archaeology and history in roman medieval and post medieval greece honor the contributions of timothy e gregory to our understanding of greece from the roman period to modern times evoking gregory s diverse interests the volume brings together anthropologists art historians archaeologists historians and philologists to address such contested topics as the end of antiquity the so called byzantine dark ages the contours of the emerging byzantine civilization and identity in post medieval greece these papers demonstrate the continued vitality of both traditional and innovative approaches to the study of material culture and emphasise that historical interpretation should be the product of methodological self awareness in particular this volume shows how the study of the material culture of post classical greece over the last 30 years has made significant contributions to both the larger archaeological and historical discourse the essays in this volume are organized under three headings archaeology and method the archaeology of identity and the changing landscape which highlight three main focuses of gregory s research each essay interlaces new analyses with the contributions gregory has made to our understanding of medieval and post medieval greece read together these essays not only make a significant contribution to how we understand the post classical greek world but also to how we study the material culture of the mediterranean world more broadly

this volume produced in honour of professor david a hinton s contribution to medieval studies re visits the sites archaeologists and questions which have been central to the archaeology of medieval southern england contributions are focused on the medieval period from the anglo saxon period to the reformation in southern england

with one of the richest archaeological records and most complicated histories in the mediterranean sardinia provides an important laboratory for studying the interaction of indigenous societies and outside forces in a partly isolated geographical context stephen l dyson and robert j rowland jr use both material culture and written documents to reconstruct the social and economic processes of an island society that showed both cultural creativity and continuity but responded to invasions from the phoenicians through the romans to the aragoneses this first accessible reconstruction of island archaeology provides a balanced picture of the sweep of sardinian history

this revised edition of dr neville a ritchie s 1986 phd dissertation explores the history and archaeology of the 19th century chinese mining communities in the clutha valley new zealand lavishly illustrated with black and white line drawings of chinese domestic and industrial sites and of the artefacts excavated from them this study offers unprecedented insight into the life and material culture of these male only sojourner communities widely considered the most comprehensive archaeological study of overseas chinese miners experience anywhere in the world this volume contains the total summation and analysis of artefacts found in 23 chinese sites excavated over nine years which included two camps with 40 individual huts and other features a chinese store and 20 rural sites including miners huts and rock shelters considered by the australian society for historical archaeology to be a seminal work in the field of historical archaeology this 2023 edition introduces dr ritchie s groundbreaking work to the next generation of archaeologists

this festschrift volume celebrates tim murray s significant and wide ranging contribution to archaeological thought and practice it includes 27 papers by tim murray s colleagues research collaborators and students former and current together these comprise a substantive and reflective contribution to archaeology history philosophy and cultural heritage in australia oceania china india the united kingdom northern europe and north america the collected papers in this volume tie together murray s research into the history or historiography of archaeological thought and his commitment to understanding the material culture of the past to write history they provide a cross section of philosophical enquiries and substantive research from epistemological studies of shared lexicons and important debates in the history of archaeological thought to the minutiae of material culture studies several papers explicitly and implicitly explore one of murray s great interests the role of heritage preservation in our exploration of the past including dedicated tertiary training programs for indigenous australians to manage research and protect their own country the book is divided into four parts history archaeology

philosophy and heritage offering an interdisciplinary approach to the study of the past this volume would be of interest to archaeologists historians philosophers of archaeology and heritage scholars

this collection of essays the bulk of which have been previously published by emeritus professor tim murray ranges widely across contemporary archaeological theory and the history of archaeology while retaining a focus on the archaeology of australia the collection is introduced by a new essay the evolution of archaeological theory that sets the agenda for the collection in doing this murray explores the critical intersection between archaeology philosophy and the social and cultural context of its practice in australia and elsewhere the collection brings together ideas about time scale and strategies for the evaluation of archaeological concepts and categories which are then applied to an understanding of significant issues raised by writing the archaeology of australia from the pleistocene to the present the essays have been drawn from over 30 years of research and writing about archaeological inquiry into the theories and methods of the discipline and will be of particular interest to archaeologists historians the managers of archaeological heritage and advocates of the importance of indigenous perspectives on the histories of post colonial societies

in history archaeology and the bible forty years after historicity hjelm and thompson argue that a crisis broke in the 1970s when several new studies of biblical history and archaeology were published questioning the historical critical method of biblical scholarship the crisis formed the discourse of the copenhagen school s challenge of standing positions which together with new achievements in archaeological research demand that the regional history of ancient israel judaea and palestine be reconsidered in all its detail this volume examines the major changes that have taken place within the field of old testament studies since the ground breaking works of thomas thompson and john van seters in 1974 and 1975 both republished in 2014 the book is divided in three sections changing perspectives in biblical studies history and cult and ideology and history presenting new articles from some of the field s best scholars with comprehensive discussion of historical archaeological anthropological cultural and literary approaches to the hebrew bible and palestine s history the essays question how does biblical history relate to the archaeological history of israel and palestine and can we view the history of the region independently of a biblical perspective by looking at the problem from alternative angles and questioning long held interpretations unafraid to break new ground history archaeology and the bible forty years after historicity is a vital resource to students in the field of biblical and east mediterranean studies and anyone with an interest in the archaeology history and religious development in palestine and the ancient near east

recipient of the g ernest wright award for best archaeological publication american schools of oriental research 2011 in 2007 the jaffa cultural heritage project jchp was established as a joint research endeavor of the israel antiquities authority and the cotsen institute of archaeology at the university of california los angeles among the

project's diverse aims is the publication of numerous excavations conducted in Jaffa since 1948 under the auspices of various governmental and research institutions such as the Israel Department of Antiquities and Museums and its successor the Israel Antiquities Authority as well as the Jaffa Cultural Heritage Project. This is the first volume in the Jaffa Cultural Heritage Project series. It lays the groundwork for this initiative. Part I provides the historical, economic and legal context for the JCHP's development while outlining its objectives and the unique opportunities that Jaffa offers. Researchers are given the history of Jaffa and its region, and the major episodes of cultural change that affected the site and region are explored through a series of articles. In Part II, including an illustrated discussion of historical maps of Jaffa from the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, recent archaeological discoveries from Jaffa are included. In Part III, while Part IV provides a first glimpse of the JCHP's efforts to publish the Jacob Kaplan and Haya Ritter Kaplan legacy from Jaffa, together the twenty-five contributions to this work constitute the first major book-length publication to address the archaeology of Jaffa in more than sixty years since excavations were initiated at the site.

This collection of pieces from an international range of contributors explores in detail the separation of the human past into history and archaeology.

In studying the past, archaeologists have focused on the material remains of our ancestors. Prehistorians generally have only artifacts to study and rely on the diverse material record for their understanding of past societies and their behavior. Those involved in studying historically documented cultures not only have extensive material remains but also contemporary texts, images and a range of investigative technologies to enable them to build a broader and more reflexive picture of how past societies, communities and individuals operated and behaved. Increasingly, historical archaeology refers not to a particular period, place or a method but rather an approach that interrogates the tensions between artifacts and texts irrespective of context. In short, historical archaeology provides direct evidence for how humans have shaped the world we live in today. Historical archaeology is a branch of global archaeology that has grown in the last 40 years from its North American base into an increasingly global community of archaeologists, each studying their area of the world in a historical context. Where historical archaeology started as part of the study of the post-Columbian societies of the United States and Canada, it has now expanded to interface with the post-medieval archaeologies of Europe and the diverse post-imperial experiences of Africa, Latin America and Australasia. The 36 essays in the *International Handbook of Historical Archaeology* have been specially commissioned from the leading researchers in their fields, creating a wide-ranging digest of the increasingly global field of historical archaeology. The volume is divided into two sections: the first reviewing the key themes, issues and approaches of historical archaeology today, and the second containing a series of case studies charting the development and current state of historical archaeological practice around the world. This key reference work captures the energy and diversity of this global discipline today.
