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mario rigoni stern was born in 1921 in asiago in the mountains of northeastern italy throughout his literary career he has remained deeply attached to the region of his birth its peasant customs its dialect its seasonal cycles and shifting historical fortunes tonle bintarn s story takes place in the mountains of the veneto region which once bordered the austro hungarian empire and where smuggling was a means of

subsistence for the peasant population having run afoul of a patrol of revenue agents tonle must seek refuge beyond the frontier in central europe where year after year he lives by doing odd jobs and working among other things as an itinerant print peddler a horse trainer in hungary and a gardener in a prague castle but every winter he returns secretly to his home and family until finally a pardon is granted by now his children are grown and he has little to do but tend his sheep meanwhile the times are changing social values are disintegrating under the impact of modernization and europe moves ever closer to disaster during the devastation of the first world war the occupation and ultimate destruction of his village and his own internment in an austrian camp it is tonle s loyalty to his roots and his stubborn devotion to his task as a shepherd that persist and make him a quiet symbol of heroism and human endurance

children and adults of cambodian descent or anyone interested in cambodian culture will enjoy this collection of cambodian folk and fairy tales cambodian folk stories from the gatiloke a collection of ancient cambodian folk stories have their origin in the gentle teachings of buddhist monks the settings are usually towns villages farms or forests where people live and work people with ordinary strengths and weaknesses people who face life s usual problems as they go about their daily business there are traditional stories of peasants whose quick wit saves them from thieves and scoundrels and tales of clever women who foil traps set for them by greedy nobles humorous stories ridicule unjust rulers and tell of the absurd predicaments of people animal fables teach lessons in justice wisdom and compassion some of the stories in this collection have been passed on by word of mouth from generation to generation for thousands of years others are more modern cambodian classics all portray the heart and soul of the cambodian people

throughout the book we will explore some of cambodia s most iconic cultural sites such as the angkor wat temple complex the royal palace in phnom penh and the killing fields of choeung ek we will also take you off the beaten path introducing you to some of cambodia s lesser known cultural treasures such as the traditional cambodian village of kampong khleang and the floating markets of tonle sap lake as

the mekong is the most controversial river in southeast asia and increasingly the focus of international attention it flows through 6 countries china myanmar laos thailand cambodia and viet nam the 4 downstream countries have formed the mekong river commission to promote sustainable development of the river and many of their people depend on it for their subsistence it has possible the largest freshwater fishery in the world and the mekong waters support rice agriculture in the delta in viet nam which produces about 40 of that country s food as well as in cambodia laos and thailand china is now building the first large mainstream dam on the river and has proposals for several more these dams are likely to affect the downstream countries several of the downstream countries also have plans for large scale hydropower and irrigation development which could also impact the river this book will provide a solid overview of the biophysical environment of the mekong together with a discussion of the possible impacts biophysical economic and social of some possible development scenarios it is intended to provide a technical basis which can inform the growing political and conservation debate about the future of the mekong river and those who depend on it it is aimed at river ecologists geographers environmentalists and development specialists both in the basin and especially outside for whom access to this material is most difficult this book will be the first comprehensive treatment of the mekong system the first comprehensive overview of all aspects of the mekong river system deals with a regionally critical ecosystem and one under threat the mekong supports the world s largest freshwater fishery and provides water underpinning a major regional rice paddy system presents the
